**SUBJECT: Admission to M.Sc. in the Anatomy, Physiology and Bio-Chemistry subjects in the Colleges situated in the State of Punjab-2008 onwards.**

**1. GENERAL**

- 1.1 The Governor of Punjab is pleased to authorize Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot for the selection of candidates for admission to M.Sc. in Anatomy, Physiology and Bio-Chemistry subjects in various institutions, in the State of Punjab.
- 1.2 All institutions affiliated with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot whether Government or private, aided or unaided, minority/non-minority shall be covered by this notification.
- 1.3 The admission to the minority institutions in the state of Punjab shall be done as per the notification/instructions/guidelines/rules/executive orders passed by the state Govt. as per provision of The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 and amended upto date
- 1.4 The Governor of Punjab is further pleased to notify that all the seats shall be filled up from the combined merit list based upon the merit of B.Sc. examination.
- 1.5 The Governor of Punjab is further pleased to notify that no institution shall select candidates out of any other source, or in any other manner than inter-se-merit of the candidates on the basis of merit in the qualifying examination. However, for the minority quota seats, the inter-se-merit of the candidates of the concerned minority only shall be considered. There shall be no overlapping or bye-passing of inter-se-merit of candidates seeking admission to seats in management/ minority quota except the NRI quota seats.
- 1.6 For the admission to the above courses candidates shall have to apply to the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences Faridkot. Seats shall be filled through a centralized admission committee as per provisions of the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 and amended upto date.

**2. INSTITUTIONS AND SEATS:**

- 2.1 The details of the institutions and category wise seats available in each institution affiliated with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot will be given in the prospectus. The same shall be put up on the notice board at the venue of the counseling as well as on the University website.
- 2.2 Distribution of seats shall be as per provisions of the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of fee and Making of reservation) Act, 2006 and amendment upto date.
- 2.3 The admission shall be made to all the institutions which have got the permission from the concerned authority and are affiliated to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot by 15.08.2006.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

3.1 He/She has passed qualifying examination i.e. B.Sc. (Medical) from the recognized institutions

3.2 The candidate should be a bonafide resident of Punjab. The Resident status of the Punjab State, will be taken in terms of Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3 PP II/9619, dated 6<sup>th</sup> June, 1996, ID No. 1/2/96-3PP-2/8976, dated 7<sup>th</sup> July, 1998 and ID No. letter No. 1/3/95-3PP II-81, dated 1<sup>st</sup> January 1999 and further instructions issued by the Department, if any and the same, shall be adhered to, in letter and spirit in PPMET-2007

3.3 Exemptions [under para 3.2]

- (i) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government employees, members of All India Services borne on Punjab cadre, Serving Judges and the employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies established by an act of the State of Punjab who have been holding post outside Punjab on or before 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year of entrance test that is on or before 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2007 and their children/wards/dependants were compelled to do 10+1 and/or 10+2 from outside Punjab.
- (ii) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central Government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out of the three years (2004, 2005 and 2006) preceding the year of PPMET-2007 but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependants were compelled to do 10+1 and/or 10+2 or equivalent qualifying examination from outside Punjab. However those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for these three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.
- (iii) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those Punjab Government pensioners who have retired on or before 1<sup>st</sup> January, of corresponding year and have settled outside Punjab on or before 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year of entrance test that is on or before 1<sup>st</sup> January, of the corresponding year and their children/wards/dependants were compelled to do 10+1 and/or 10+2 from outside Punjab.
- (iv) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of those military/para military forces personnel who were born in the territory of Punjab as per their service record at the time of entry into service.
- (v) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of those Ex-employees of military/para military forces who were born in the territory of Punjab as per their service record at the time of entry into the service and have retired on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year preceding two years of the year of entrance test (i.e., on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January, of the corresponding year) for the admission of 2008 onwards.
- (vi) Candidates belonging to Christian community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions respectively.
- (vii) Candidates seeking admission under Foreign Indian Student (NRI) category.
- (viii) Candidates under J & K migrant category.

**Note:** The dependency certificate in case of those whose parents are not alive shall have also to be taken from the Deputy Commissioner of the District where the candidate resides.

#### 4. RESERVATION

##### 4.1. For Government Colleges:

The reservation in the State quota seats in Government Institutes in various categories for admission will be as under.

(i)	Scheduled Castes <b>Note:</b> The reservation of SC shall be calculated on total seats in the institution whereas the rest of reservation for other categories shall be calculated on the seats left.	25%
(ii)	Backward Classes: - <b>Note:</b> The Backward Class Certificate must be as per the latest instructions of the Government of Punjab)	5%
(iii)	Backward Area/Border (1% each)	2%
(iv)	<b>Physically handicapped</b> ❖ Orthopaedically Handicapped (disability 50% to 70%) to be determined at the time of counseling by a duly constituted board of the speciality of Orthopaedics ❖ The reservation for Physically Handicapped shall be 3% out of which 1% each shall be given to the 3 categories of Handicapped falling under Visual impairment, Hearing impairment and the Orthopaedically Handicapped	3%
(v)	Sports Persons (Credit will be given for the sports achievements made during 10+1 and 10+2 classes only and shall be graded by the Director Sports, Punjab)	1%
(vi)	Wards of terrorist affected persons (in order of preference to the exclusion of next category) (a) Persons killed in terrorist action in Punjab (b) Riot affected/displaced persons (As per decisions of the Supreme Court)	1%
(vii)	Wards of Defense Personnel (in order of preference to the exclusion of next category) a. Killed in action b. Disabled in action to the extent of 50% or above and Boarded out of service c. Died while in service and Death attributed to Military service d. Disabled in service and Boarded out with disability attributed to Military Service e. Gallantry Award/other Award Winners both serving/retired. f. Serving Defense personnel/Ex-serviceman	1%
(viii)	Wards of Punjab Police Personnel, Punjab Armed Police, Punjab Home Guards, and Para-Military Forces (in order of preference to the exclusion of next category) a. Killed in action b. Disabled in action to the extent of 50% c. Winners of President's Police Medal for Gallantry of Police Medal for Gallantry	1%
(ix)	Children/grandchildren of freedom fighters.	1%
(x)	Tsunami Victims (Tsunami Victims are not required to appear in PPMET-2007. The inter-se-ranking shall be based on the marks scored in the qualifying examination i.e., 10+2 or equivalent examination).	1%

##### 4.2 For Private Institutes:

The reservation in private institutes (in Government/Management quota seats) will be as under—

(i)	Scheduled Caste	25%
(ii)	Backward Classes	5%

	Note: The Backward Class Certificate must be as per the latest instructions of Government of Punjab.	
(iii)	<b>Physically handicapped</b> ❖ Orthopaedically Handicapped (disability 50% to 70%) to be determined at the time of counseling by a duly constituted board of the specialty of Orthopaedics ❖ The reservation for Physically Handicapped shall be 3% out of which 1% each shall be given to the 3 categories of Handicapped falling under Visual impairment, Hearing impairment and the Orthopaedically Handicapped	3%
(iv)	Migrants from Jammu & Kashmir due to terrorist violence	1%

C. ❖ **Explanation:** The following points shall be observed while granting above reservation both in government and in private colleges:

- (i) A candidate under category 4.1 (iv) and 4.2 (iii), under handicapped category shall be admitted only if he/she has locomotory disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% and with this disability he/she is otherwise found fit medically to pursue the concerned course by the Medical Board duly constituted by the Government and consisting of Heads of the respective Departments to three Government Medical Colleges at Patiala, Amritsar and Faridkot.
- (ii) For the claim of reservation in category 4.1 (viii) above a certificate to this effect issued by Inspector General Police (HQ), Punjab shall have to be produced while submitting other documents. In case of Paramilitary Forces, this certificate shall be countersigned by I.G. Police (HQ) Punjab.
- (iii) The above reservation will be made in each college separately subject to the availability of seats as per instructions issued by the Government of Punjab from time to time. The reservation in each institution shall not exceed 25% in case of SC and 30% in case of SC and BC combined together.
- (iv) Candidates belonging to reserved category will be eligible for admission as per their combined merit in General category also, if they opt for the same. The reserved category candidates selected in General category will not be counted towards reserved category seat.
- (v) Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserved category shall be merged with the general category seats and vice-versa.

## 5. Foreign Indian Students (NRI) Seats

- 5.1 15% of seats in all Private Institutes shall be earmarked for the Foreign Indian Students (NRI). The Foreign Indian Students NRI quota in private institutes will be part of the management quota.
- 5.2 The candidates applying against quota for Foreign Indian Students (NRI) in these institutions will be admitted on merit determined on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. The equivalence, merit and eligibility of the candidates will be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, who will issue an eligibility certificate to such candidates.
- 5.3 The criteria laid down for admission against seats reserved for NRI candidates will be as under:-
  1. First preference will be given to those Foreign Indian Students NRI candidates who are having ancestral Punjab Resident background.
  2. Second preference will be given to those Foreign Indian Students NRI candidates who are having ancestral background of States of India other than Punjab.

Note: -

- (a) If sufficient number of candidates under first category are eligible and available then they will be admitted first even if students under subsequent category (ies) are higher in merit.
- (b) The Foreign Indian Students NRI quota students will have to submit a bank guarantee for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments.
- (c) Any seats remaining vacant under Foreign Indian Students NRI quota till last date of admission shall go to general pool/management/minority quota.

## 6. ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

### 6.1 ELIGIBILITY: -

For admission to these courses, the candidate must have secured at least 50% marks (40% for SC/BC) in the qualifying examination.

- 6.2 The selection shall be strictly as per merit based upon the B.Sc. (Medical) preference will be given to the candidates having passed B.Sc. Examination in relevant subject.
- 6.3 Counseling shall be compulsory; however, the candidate may opt to change choice of station and course at the time of counseling. The schedule of the counseling shall be published in the prospectus by the University.
- 6.4 **EQUAL MARKS:** - In case of candidates securing equal marks, their inter-se-merit will be determined as under:
  - (i) First the candidate having higher percentage of aggregate marks calculated up to 3 decimal points.
  - (ii) Then the candidate having higher marks in the subject for which the candidate is seeking admission.
  - (iii) Then the Candidate, older in age.
- 6.5 Government quota seats remaining vacant will be transferred to management quota and vice-versa.
- 6.6 The admission to management quota seats shall be through a centralized counseling and receipt of application by the Baba University of Health Sciences. Government quota seats remaining vacant will be transferred to Management Quota and vice-versa.
- 6.7 **Declaration by students:-** Candidates and their parents will have to give a declaration if they (candidates) have already got admission in a Course/State that they will leave that seat if they opt for admission and will send a copy of the declaration to the concerned institute where they have already deposited fee/occupied a seat.

## 7. SELECTION COMMITTEES

The following committee is constituted for conducting the counseling and finalizing the admissions:

## 8. FEE

### (a) For Admission:

The Cost of Prospectus, application fee for admission shall be notified by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

- (b) **Private Colleges:** As fixed by the Government from time to time.

**Note:**

- (a) The fee will be payable on annual basis and the colleges will insist to deposit of fee of the entire course in advance. At the most students can be asked to submit a Bank Guarantee, that they will be liable to pay the balance fee for the rest of the courses even if they leave in midstream.
- (b) The fee shall be refunded/adjusted if candidate is shifted from one course/college to another in subsequent round of counseling/operation of waiting list.

**(c) Hostel fee and Security Advance (Annual and provisional)**

- (i) General Independent Room Rs. 12,000 per year (Maximum) for single bed
- (ii) Special Room (Attached bathroom and AC) Rs. 20,000/- per year Maximum.
- (iii) Security Advance Rs. 10,000 or its equivalent (to be refundable at the completion of courses).
- (iv) Mess charges-Actual and to be managed by the students  
(These charges are exclusive of electricity/water but inclusive of everything else.)

**(d) Government Colleges shall charge the fee already fixed by the Government, which are as under annually**

**Note:** The fee for private institutes shall be as per rate fixed by the Government of Punjab as per provisions of The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 and amended upto date.

**9. GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- (a) The students shall pay the fees and other charges, for all types of seats, as per the rates of fees and other charges fixed by the Government of Punjab.
- (b) Management/Minority Quota including Foreign Indian Students seats will be filled up as per the notifications/instructions/guidelines/executive orders by the State Government as per provisions of The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and

Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 or any directions or the order of the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court/Supreme Court of India.

- (c) The seats available for admission will be displayed on the notice board of the University.
- (d) Waiting list of all successful candidates will be prepared by the Chairman, Selection Committee and the details of vacant seats shall be displayed on the notice board. The waiting list shall be operated by the Chairman calling the candidates for Counseling.
- (e) No fee will be charged by the University to remain in the waiting list. However, the admission fee will be collected by the concerned Institution at the time of admission.
- (f) The fee shall be refunded if a candidate is shifted from one course to the other on operation of waiting list.
- (g) The admission shall be made to only those institutes, which are affiliated to the University on or before 31<sup>st</sup> of July of corresponding year. Institute(s) which have applied for affiliation and/or for approval of competent authority (ies) but are unable to get affiliation/ approval before 31<sup>st</sup> of July of corresponding year shall not be considered for admission.
- (h) The Medical Board to determine requisite disability at the time of admission will be constituted by the Chairman Selection Committee/University. The candidate shall be admitted only if he/she has minimum of the requisite disability and with this disability is otherwise found fit medically to pursue the concerned course, by a duly constituted Medical Board.
- (i) In order to ensure completion of the prescribed course (s) and period of study as well as commencement of examination(s) in time, no admission (s) adjustment (s) shall be made after 30<sup>th</sup> December of the corresponding year regardless of any vacancy (ies) that might exist or might arise thereafter for any reason whatsoever.
- (j) **Transfer of seats to management quota: -**  
Government quota seats remaining vacant will be transferred to management quota and filled up by the University as per provisions of this notification, strictly as per their merit, after obtaining a certificate from the Selection Committees/University that there are no candidates available with them and they are unable to fill up the government quota.
- (k) No admissions shall be made after 30<sup>th</sup> December of the corresponding year including the left over seats.

Any notification/instructions issued earlier shall not be applicable to admission for the Session 2008-09 onwards.

For any dispute arising out of this notification or of the admissions under this notification, the jurisdiction shall be Punjab and Chandigarh only.
