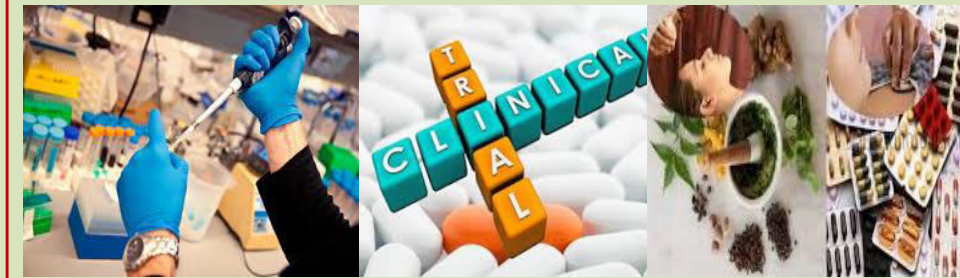

INTRODUCTION

Clinical trials is very promising area of research these days. There is a need to know about the intricacies of running clinical trials at societal level, industry level, scientific level and ethical standards. There is a great dilemma in industry about research and development of genetically modified foods/ vaccine/ herbal drugs/ medicines/fermented foods and other biotechnology based products. At the same time scientists/regulatory authorities are not properly aware about regulations and hence need awareness on the issue.

The Indian herbal drug market size is about \$1 billion and the export of plant based crude drug is about \$ 100 million. Also the contribution of developing countries in global herbal business is very poor due to lack of quality control and standardization measures i.e. appropriate methods of evaluating traditional medicines to ensure safety, efficacy and quality control and the knowledge of plants used for herbal drug preparation.

In most of the developing countries there are no guidelines which could give a smooth drive to a clinical researcher for a clinical trial of herbal drugs. Most of the industry people who want to invest in herbal drug research face a big constraint for indulging into it, just because there are no clear cut guidelines by regulatory bodies. Due to increasing demand of herbal drugs, India is losing a lot of revenue just because of lack of set patterns guiding clinical research and herbal based product development. Being clinical researchers it is our duty to make the scientists, physicians, postgraduate students, industry and top regulatory authorities aware about potentials and bottlenecks of clinical trials in herbal drugs so as to enable our country to come forward in clinical trials in herbal drugs and hold a significant part of revenue generated by herbal product development. Further there is a need to disseminate the importance of human subjects in clinical research and clinical trials. There is also a need to make all the stake holders aware of their duties and responsibilities towards human subjects (specially enabled persons).

The conference will give an insight into these issues for betterment of industry academia partnership and regulatory authorities. Special lectures are being organized on clinical trials of genetically engineered products; nanotechnology based products and fermented formulations. The major objective of the event is to disseminate the knowledge of clinical trials to scientists, herbal industry and regulatory authorities about clinical trials. A special session will be organized to make the stake holders aware of the recent developments in medicine/diagnostic techniques/medical instruments used for specially enabled persons. A special lecture shall be organized on regulations and ethical issues related to the involvement of specially enabled persons in clinical trials.

This National Science Day celebration shall make all the concerned aware about the importance of human subjects in clinical trials, ethical standards, compensation guidelines. A special poster session for post graduate students/MBBS students/Pharmacy students and other science students shall be organized to disseminate the importance of above objectives.
