The institution is expected to make payment as per the negotiated rates from their own resources directly to the publisher.

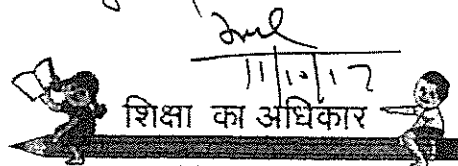
