SINPMS, AT A GLANCE

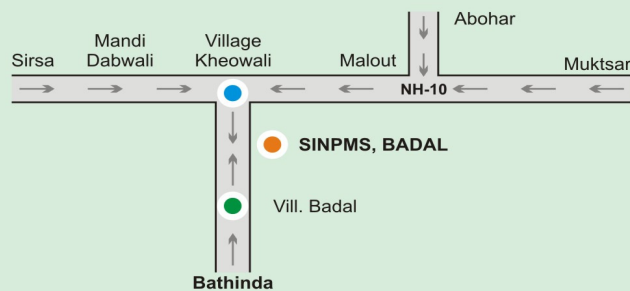

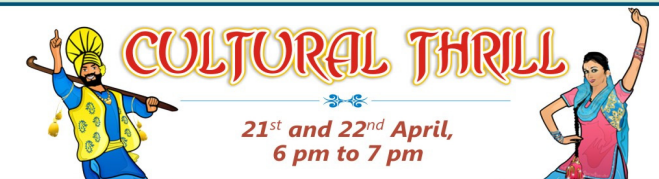
