About Faridkot

Faridkot town is believed to be founded and named as Mokalhar in the 12th Century by Raja Mohalsi (also called Mohkal Dev), the 9th descendent of Manjh from the clan of Jaisal Bhatti Rajput- who founded Jaisalmer. In the 13th century, the famous Sufi Saint Hazrat Baba Sheikh Farid on his way to Pakpattan (now in Pakistan) from Delhi happened to pass through this Princely State and caught by the man of raja Mokhal dev. The Baba Farid pardoned the Raja and meditated at a place near the Fort, now known as "Tilla Baba Farid" where he penanced for 40 days before proceeding to pakpattan (now in Pakistan). From that day the name of Mokalhar was changed to Faridkot with the permission of sufi-saint Baba Farid ji.

The city, Faridkot is one of the districts of Punjab, located in Malwa region. The sites worth seeing are, Tilla Baba Farid ji, Gurudwara Godri Sahib, Traditional fort, Indo Pakistan Border, Hussainiwala (35 kms from Faridkot).

Aim of the workshop
