Philosophy of the course :

The philosophy of Nurse Assistant is to promote quality of patient care; to provide entry-level skills for employment as a nurse assistant / orderly and to provide awareness of opportunities/choices in health care occupations...The nurse assistant curriculum is based upon the following beliefs

- Clients have the right to optimum health care delivered in a safe environment by a competent caregiver.
- Learning occurs in an atmosphere of mutual respect; where questioning is welcomed, and opportunities for guided practice based on practical knowledge.
- The nurse assistant/ orderly is an important member of the health care team. The nurse assistant, under the direct supervision of nursing personnel, provided direct care to the client; promotes comfort measures, and collects, records and reports data.

Clients have the right to the fulfillment of their basic physical, psychosocial, and spiritual needs."

Aim of the nurse assistant course:

The aim / purpose of the certificate course in nurse assistant is to provide an educational program which will be prepared to assume responsibility in the providing first aid and emergency support services to the clients at different level at road side, in hospital- emergency department, and appropriate shifting and transportation of the patients to another department existing in hospital . Nurse assistant will be bringing awareness to masses about emergency management of the casualties, their first aid and appropriate transportation to tertiary care hospitals with safety precaution required for patients to minimize further damage.

Objectives of the course :

A nurse assistant/ orderly successfully completing the certificate training program will be able to-

1. Describe the basic structure and functions of human body so he/ she can apply the knowledge in caring the client at different level.
2. Function effectively as a nurse assistant / orderly to provide comprehensive health care in a community, hospital in as well as urban and rural locations & in home based care.
3. To demonstrate competence in providing emergency care to save the life of injured clients in different settings.
4. Provide first aid to the injured or the sick in emergency & able to demonstrate skill in cardio pulmonary resuscitation in casualty or hospital setting and home environment.
5. To explain the local patterns of disease and minor ailments and their management.
6. Helps in collecting, handling and transporting the specimens for various diagnostic tests.
7. Help the nurse in serving the therapeutic diet for various disease conditions.
8. To provide congenial and safe environment to the patients in carrying out elementary nursing procedures & wound care, dressing for better patients care.
9. To provide first aid in case of disaster, emergency, and accidents and demonstrate skills in transportations of the casualties.
10. Identify common equipments used for patients care in wards and operation theatres.

Admission Terms & Conditions:

- Duration of course** : 6 months
- Admission Qualification** : 10th standard
- Minimum Age** : 17 years and the marital status of the candidate are

- Admission** : January / July (**Twice a year**)
- Medium of instruction** : Regional language (Hindi / Punjabi/ English)
- Vacations & Holiday** : Sick leave not more than 5 days
Preparatory holidays 7 days

The Nurse Assistant course provides the student with the necessary skills to seek employment in long-term care facilities as Nurse Assistant. Emphasis is on elementary principles of nursing, development and application of activities of daily living skills in hospital & long-term care facilities.

6. Upper Age Relaxation for in-service candidate up to 35 years and in case of SC/ BC as per Punjab Government rules.
