**Subject: Checking/Verification of Original Certificate/Documents for admission to MBBS/BDS Courses, Session 2017.**

**Sir/Madam,**

In continuation of this office letter no. No.03 BFUHS/Admn/Asst./2017/ 19313-34 Date: 17/07/17 the following instructions for all the Medical/Dental colleges in state of Punjab are also for compliance as under:

The candidates allocated to the Medical/Dental colleges will directly report to the concerned colleges for verification of certificates, checking of eligibility, medical checkup and joining as per the schedule.

- 1) Allocation of seat is purely provisional subject to the final document verification and checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned college.
- 2) The University will provide User id and Password to all Principals of Medical/Dental Colleges for online admission process of NEET UG-2017.
- 3) After verification of documents of the candidates, the Principal will provide a copy of bank challan form to the candidate and instruct to candidate **for depositing the fee only through bank draft in favour of "Registrar , Baba Farid University of Health Sciences" payable at "Faridkot".** The candidate will thereafter submit the Demand Draft to the concerned Principal.
- 4.) After verification of documents by the College, if college found any discrepancy in the documents produced by the applicant or eligibility of the candidates is not as per Punjab Govt. Notification then the Principal concerned will immediately inform the same to the University and the applicant will not be admitted till the further directions from the University.
- 5.) Eligibility criteria for admission in Government & Private Medical/Dental Institute , including Institutes under Private Universities and Minority Institutions for MBBD and BDS seats, shall be in accordance with eligibility criteria/qualifications/qualifying criteria as prescribed in the information Bulletin for National Eligibility –cum-Entrance Test(NEET) issued by CBSE for the corresponding year. # INFORMATION BULLETIN

## NEET (UG) 2017

### 4 Qualifications and Qualifying Examination Codes

#### CODE : 01

A candidate who is appearing in the qualifying examination, i.e., 12<sup>th</sup> Standard in 2017, whose result is awaited, may apply and take up the said test but he/she shall not be eligible for admission to the MBBS or BDS, if he/she does not pass the qualifying examination with the required pass percentage of marks at the time of first round of Counselling.

OR

#### CODE : 02

The Higher/Senior Secondary Examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination which is equivalent to 10+2 Higher/Senior Secondary Examination after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of such study comprising of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology (which shall include practical tests in these subjects) and Mathematics or any other elective subject with English at a level not less than the core course for English as prescribed by the National Council of Educational Research and Training after introduction of the 10+2+3 educational structure as recommended by the National Committee on Education.

NOTE: where the course content is not as prescribed for 10+2 education structure of the National Committee, the candidates will have to undergo a period of one year pre - professional training before admission to the Medical Colleges.

OR

#### CODE : 03

The Intermediate/Pre-degree Examination in Science of an Indian University/Board or other recognised examining body with Physics, Chemistry, Biology /Bio-technology (which shall include practical test in these subjects) and also English as a compulsory subject.

OR

#### CODE : 04

The Pre-professional/Pre-medical Examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology & English after passing either the Higher Secondary Examination or the Pre-University or an equivalent examination. The Pre-professional/Pre-medical examination shall include practical test in these subjects and also English as a compulsory subject.

OR

#### CODE : 05

The first year of the three years' degree course of a recognised University with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Bio-technology including practical tests in these subjects provided the examination is a University Examination and candidate has passed the earlier qualifying examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Bio-technology with English at a level not less than a core course.

OR

#### CODE : 06

B.Sc. Examination of an Indian University provided that he/she has passed the B.Sc. Examination with not less than two of the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology)/Bio-technology and further that he/ she has passed the earlier qualifying examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

OR

#### CODE : 07

Any other examination which in scope and standard (Last 02 years of 10+2 Study comprising of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology; Which shall include practical test in these subjects) is found to be equivalent to the Intermediate Science Examination of an Indian University/Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology including practical tests in each of these subjects and English.

Provided that to be eligible for competitive entrance examination, candidate must have passed any of the qualifying examinations as enumerated above or appearing in the qualifying examination in 2017. Provided also that to be eligible for competitive Entrance Test the candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology at the qualifying examination as mentioned in clause (2) of regulation 4 on Graduate Medical Education 1997 and in addition must have come in the merit list of NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY ENTRANCE TEST (UG) – 2017 for admission to MBBS/BDS courses.

In respect of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology taken together in qualifying examination shall be 40% marks instead of 50% marks for General Candidates. Further, for persons with locomotor disability of lower limbs, minimum of 45% marks for Gen-PH and 40% marks for SC-PH/ST-PH/OBC-PH are required.

Provided further that the students educated abroad seeking admission into medical colleges in India must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology and English up to the 12<sup>th</sup> standard level with 50% marks and their equivalency determined as per regulations of the Medical Council of India and the concerned University. If a candidate does not fall within the qualifications prescribed as per Code number 01-07
