2. **These applications will be considered for all time for all colleges for admission session-2023 provided fulfillment of terms and conditions of Punjab Government Notification and Prospectus.**
3. The list of colleges alongwith its status regarding approval of competent authorities is published in this Prospectus. Candidates are advised to see the Status of college in respect of approval of competent authorities for admission session 2023 viz. affiliation with BFUHS, suitability of Indian Nursing Council, approval of PNRC and Punjab Govt. before getting admission in particular college. The candidates who will get admission in colleges who do not have suitability of Indian Nursing Council will not be eligible for registration outside Punjab State.
4. The candidates who have applied under Sports category will have to submit printed/hard copy of online submitted application form personally (by hand) in the University upto **stipulated date/time** alongwith sports gradation certificates issued by the Director, Sports, Punjab and other supporting self-attested copies of certificates/documents.

Only those sports category candidates will be considered who will apply in the 1<sup>st</sup> round of counselling and who will upload the valid sports gradation certificate issued by the Director sports, Punjab.

Credit shall be given only for the sports achievements made during class XI and XII. The admission shall be made on the basis of inter-se merit of the candidates determined on the basis of gradation (Category A/B/C) issued by the Director of Sports, Punjab. However, for exempted categories under para 12 of this notification, the competent authority will be Director, Sports of that State of U.T. from where the candidate has passed the class XI and XII examinations.

3. Candidates who want to shift/upgrade seat in another college or who have not filled preferences in 1<sup>st</sup> round of counselling will submit online preferences of colleges/category through University website [www.bfuchs.ac.in](http://www.bfuchs.ac.in) in the 2nd online counselling. All choices filled in first round will be treated as null and void. Only fresh choices will be considered in 2nd online counselling. Those candidates who are satisfied with his/her 1st round of allotment and joined the college, need not to submit preferences & will retain first round of seat.
4. The allotment in the counseling will be provisional and subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Nursing College at the time of joining/reporting. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the allocated candidate as per Punjab Government notification/prospectus before joining/admission.
5. Only PPBNET appeared (qualified/unqualified) candidates of Punjab will be considered in the 1<sup>st</sup> round of online counselling.
6. The candidates who are not bonafide resident of Punjab (except those who are exempted in clause (4 A) will be considered in 2<sup>nd</sup>/subsequent counseling after exhausting Punjab State candidates.
7. **The Last date for admission to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course is 30.09.2023 in reference to Indian Nurisng Council notification No.F.No.1-6/(LT)-2023-INC dated 13.04.2023 or any other date as notified by INC/Govt. of Punjab from time to time.**

## 1. INTRODUCTION

**BRIEF HISTORY:** The University was established at Faridkot under an Act of Punjab State Legislature (Punjab Act No. 18 of 1998) in the name of great Sufi Saint Sheikh Farid Ganj-E-Shakar, (1173 1265 A.D.) in 1998 for purposes of affiliating, teaching and ensuring proper and systematic instruction, training and research in Modern Systems of Medicine and Indian Systems of Medicine. It is not only affiliating and examining body but also a teaching and research centre in health sciences. It is expected to play a vital role in improving the standards of medical and health education in the state and in conducting relevant research in all aspects of health sciences, basic as well as applied, which ultimately will ameliorate the health standards of the people of Punjab. It is believed that the university will be a trend setter in developing appropriate modes and models of health care to ensure quality health care to the people.

The University has been recognized by MCI vide letter no. V/11015/3/2000-ME (UG) dated 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2000. The UGC has also included the University in the list of recognized universities maintained by the University Grants Commission, under section 2(1) of the UGC Act. 1956 vide letter no. F.9-3/97 (CPP-I) dated 4 July. 2002. The Regional Director. World Health Organization, Regional Office for South-East Asia, World Health House, New Delhi has also forwarded the name of the University for inclusion in the World Directory of Medical Schools vide letter No. M12/6212 dated 6 May 2002. The University is also included in the list of Commonwealth Universities and their yearbook 2001 at page No. 692 (Vol. I).

Established with a mission to create an intellectual, academic and physical environment conducive to free flow of ideas and exchange of information between various faculties of the university, between this university and other universities of health sciences in the country and abroad, thereby opening a window to the world for the health professionals, health planners, health managers, biomedical and social scientists and educationalists in health sciences of the country. Efforts are on to establish contact with various institutions towards achieving this goal.

**UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS:** All the new buildings of the University and its constituent college, GGS Medical College & Hospital were completed in the year 2011. The university was shifted to its new building situated at Sadiq Road, Faridkot in July 2011. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab. Inaugurated two new University buildings (Senate Block and Academic Block) on 22-09-2011 Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister inaugurated the Radiotherapy Unit, and other buildings of GGS Medical College & Hospital, on 23-09-2011. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University is also shifted to its new building.

The University Campus comprises of GGS Medical College along with Auditorium of 800 capacity, Senate Block, Academic Block, University College of Physiotherapy, University College of Nursing, Drug De-addiction Centre, Telemedicine, Edusat and a well equipped state-of-the-art 500 bedded hospital. Coveted projects to set up Trauma Centre, Regional Cancer Centre all in process. The University has added to its academic convoy University Library & Informatics Division, Department of Health Sciences Library & Information System, University Centre of Excellence in Research, Rose Garden and Herbal Garden.

**UNIVERSITY'S NEW PROJECTS:** University is on the way to establish

- 1) Advanced Cancer Diagnostic, Treatment & Research Centre at Bathinda.
- 2) University Regional Centre for Public Health & Paramedical Sciences at Goindwal Sahib.

University has acquired 20 Acres of land for its Regional Center at Goindwal Sahib. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab has already inaugurated both the projects in October 2011. The University has planned to run a number of employment-oriented diploma courses and certificate programmes in health sciences.

The University is also in process of developing the following five study centres:

1. Centre for Distance Learning (Medical) and Educational Technology miscellaneous.
2. Centre for Health Systems and Health Services Management.
3. Centre for Bio-information Technology.
4. Centre for Human Resources Development and Health Management.
5. Centre for Population Sciences.

**UNIVERSITY'S CONSTITUENT COLLEGES:** The Government of Punjab incorporated the three institutions as constituent colleges of the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot viz. School of Nursing (upgraded to University College of Nursing) vide notification no. 11/299/01-5SS3/4770 dated 14.10.2002, Guru Gobind Singh Medical College & 500

bedded Hospital. Faridkot vide notification no. 8/02/2005-1HB-I11/6308 dated 31.10.2006 and State Institute of Nursing & Paramedical Sciences, Badal vide notification no. 1/46/07-1HBIV/1163 dated 28.11.2007. In addition to above, the Board of Management of University also accepted the proposal for starting of Physiotherapy College in the University campus in its meeting held on dated 03.04.2007 and fourth constituent college was established viz. University College of Physiotherapy. University has also established its own Institute of Pharmacy. Recently, Govt. of Punjab has transferred 100 bedded Civil Hospital, Badal to University for strengthening and expanding the connection between rural medical services and the education and research carried on by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University has 25 departments and 20 post graduate departments and is recognized by MCI.

At present the University is having 160 affiliated colleges(10 Medical,14 Dental, 120 Nursing, 11 Physiotherapy, 1 Pharmacy, 1 Sports Medicine and 3 para medical) comprising 151 affiliated and 9 constituent Colleges.

University will soon endeavor to achieve excellence in health care delivery and medical education and research in the State. Admissions to various undergraduate and post graduate courses in the affiliated institutions of this University in the State of Punjab are made on merit basis through the conduct of Entrance Tests.

The university is now primarily focusing on strengthening postgraduate medical education and research and evolving as a centre of excellence in a rural backdrop.

5. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Prospectus and University website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
6. **Candidates must retain the following documents with them as reference for future correspondence.**
  - a. At least three printouts of online submitted application form.
  - b. Proof of fee paid
  - c. 3 copies of latest identical coloured Photograph with date (taken after 01-01-2023 & should be passport size with white background) that scanned and uploaded on the Online Application form.

**Note: 1.** Photograph should not have cap or goggles. Spectacles are allowed if being used regularly. POLAROID and COMPUTER generated photos are not acceptable. Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected. **Candidates may please note that if it is found that photograph affixed is fabricated i.e. de-shaped or seems to be hand-made or computer made, the form of the candidate will be rejected and the same would be considered as using unfair means practices and candidate would accordingly be dealt with the rules of unfair means.**

2. Candidate must ensure that mobile numbers, E-mail address filled in the online Application form are his/her own as University will make communications by SMS or mail on given mobile number and mailing ID only.

3. The Candidate himself/herself shall be held responsible for non-receipt of latest information due to wrong mobile number or mailing address filled in the online Application Form.

**PLEASE READ IN DETAILS**

1. All necessary information regarding the taking of PPBNET-2023, allocation of merit and seeking admission to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course in the various Nursing colleges of Punjab affiliated to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot and all applicable rules and regulations, etc., are contained in this PROSPECTUS, PPBNET - 2023.
2. This Prospectus contains two parts:  
**Part-I:** Pertains to the instructions/procedure how to fill online application forms for PPBNET- 2023, Mode of PPBNET-2023 and allotment of ranks. It also contains instructions/procedure of online counselling and method of allocation of seats.  
**Part-II:** Pertains to admission to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course on the basis of PPBNET - 2023. This part contains the **Punjab Government Notification No. 5/21/2013-5HB-III/Spl. dated 28-08-2021**, Syllabus for PPBNET, specimen of category, Punjab resident and other Performa's.
3. Candidates are advised to read both Part-I and Part-II of the prospectus carefully before filling and submitting the **ONLINE APPLICATION FORM** of PPBNET -2023.
4. **An error in filling of ONLINE APPLICATION FORM may result in rejection of such an Application Form. Corrections in the information given by the candidate in the ONLINE APPLICATION FORM may not be permitted after lock of application form as last date of submission of application form.**
5. The schedule of Admission/Counselling shall be notified through the Press or University, website. Changes, if any, in the schedule/time table of Test/Counselling etc. will be notified through Press/website of the University i.e. [www.bfuhs.ac.in](http://www.bfuhs.ac.in) **No separate intimation letters will be sent.**
6. Candidates must retain this Prospectus with them till admission process is over. Read and comply with all instructions therein strictly.
7. **COBSE (Counsel of Board of School Education in India)** grant membership to boards/institutions that are set up by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature or by an Executive orders of the Central / State Government and broadly follow the National Curriculum Framework/CBSE. Therefore, candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from member-boards of COBSE are acceptable for admissions. A complete list of members-boards of COBSE can be downloaded from [www.cobse.in](http://www.cobse.in). Boards not in the list of members-boards of COBSE shall not be acceptable for admissions. The Board of Management in its meeting held on 21.08.2013 vide para no. 28, resolved that the list of Boards recognized by COBSE shall be considered for admission to higher courses run by the University.
8. The list of the Colleges and availability of seats shown at various places in this prospectus may vary and **the final status shall be displayed at the time of counselling.**
9. There will be no negative marking. **However the candidates who do not darken the fifth oval (i.e. option- E introduced for security reasons) in case of un-attempted questions shall be getting deduction of marks at the rate of one mark per question left in which all the five ovals have been left blank.**
10. The candidate should read the eligibility conditions carefully and just appearing in PPBNET does not entitle him/her for admission. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in the Notification (Part-II). The candidates will appear in PPBNET at their own risk & responsibility. Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Nursing College. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the allocated candidate before joining/admission. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Government Notification will not be considered for admission.
11. Fill category carefully in the online Admission Application Form. Category once claimed will not be changed in any case after submitting the form. Those candidates, who do not fill/claim any category code as per prospectus or fill a wrong category code other than mentioned in prospectus, will be treated in Open merit.

The candidate may select a category code from the codes given below and fill the category accordingly. More than one category may be filled by a candidate if it is considered applicable in the candidate's particular case. Category codes are exclusively for the purpose of facilitating the candidates to know and understand his/her respective merit placement at the time of counseling in various reserved categories as have been filled by him/her. Reserve category selection on the part of the candidate shall not in any case be construed to give him/her any legitimacy or right or claim on the benefits for reserved seats during admission. Claims to admissions against reserved seats in Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing courses will be on the basis of appropriate claims made in the Admission Application Form subject to rules and regulations contained in the Punjab Government Notifications printed in the Part-B of this prospectus and as per the decisions of the Selection Committee constituted for this purpose by the Punjab Government. No benefit of reservation whatsoever shall be given if the claim is not made in online Admission Application Form.

12. This is for the information of all candidates that as per Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.

13. **Post Matric Scholarship Scheme:**

SC category candidates are entitled for scholarship from the Department of Welfare, Govt. of Punjab if they fulfill their terms and conditions. SC category candidates, whose family/guardians income from all sources does not exceed Rs.2,50,000/-(Rupees Two Lakh fifty thousand only) during the last Financial Year, are entitled for post matric scholarship as per guidelines of Govt. of India and Punjab Govt. The candidates will have to submit Freeship Card alongwith admission application form. For details regarding this scheme/forms/procedure, respective colleges/candidates should visit the website of Punjab Govt., Deptt. of Medical Education and Research ([www.punjabmedicaleducation.org](http://www.punjabmedicaleducation.org)) and University website ([www.bfuhs.ac.in](http://www.bfuhs.ac.in)). For any query/clarification, candidates/respective colleges can contact the office of Director, Medical Education and Research, Punjab, Chandigarh or Director, Welfare Deptt., Punjab, Chandigarh. For further information and applying for scholarship candidates may visit <http://www.punjabscholarships.gov.in>. It is also responsibility of the concerned candidate to ensure that has filled his/her application for scholarship is filled in time.

## PROCEDURE OF ONLINE COUNSELLING AND JOINING AT THE COLLEGES

Counselling for admission to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course, session 2023 will be conducted online. The candidates will submit online choices / preferences of Colleges, category etc. through university website ([www.bfuhs.ac.in](http://www.bfuhs.ac.in)). The Seats will be allocated as per the PPBNET-2023 merit / eligibility criteria as mentioned in the Punjab Government notification in order of preferences given by the candidate, therefore, candidates are advised to submit preferences / choices carefully.

After provisional allocation of seat, candidates can download provisional allocation letter from the University website after login to their account and report to the respective allotted college along with all original documents for the checking of documents and their eligibility. Merely, issuing of Provisional allotment letter does not confer any right to claim the allocated seat as their provisional allotment is subject to verification of documents and checking of eligibility as per terms and conditions of Punjab Govt. Notification/Prospectus.

If any candidate will not report for joining to the respective college upto stipulated period or will not pay the requisite counselling/tuition fee etc. or found ineligible as per Punjab Government notification at any stage, his/her allocated seat will be cancelled automatically without any intimation and his/her seat shall be declared as vacant for the subsequent round of counseling.

If candidate is satisfied with seat allocated to him/her during online counselling, he/she is not required to participate in the subsequent rounds of counselling. In case, candidate wishes/intends to upgrade/change his/her seat/category then he/she will have to participate in the subsequent round of counselling by submitting preferences/choices afresh for the course/college/category/quota.

If any candidate wants to surrender/quit the course/seat, he/she will have to submit the written request to the Principal of respective college for surrender of seat before the university will declare the vacant seats for subsequent round of counselling so that resultant vacated seat can be added in the vacancy position of seats.

In case candidate is shifted /upgraded his seat in the subsequent round of counselling then there is no need to deposit tuition fee again but he/she has to deposit the difference in fee (if any).

It is pertinent to mention here that during the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of online counseling, the candidates can fill the choices of colleges/category/quota as per their choice although which are not reflecting in the vacancy position of seats because during 2<sup>nd</sup> online counseling any candidate can upgrade/shift seat as per his/her choice by vacating the already occupied seat of 1<sup>st</sup> counseling. This is also made clear that some seats of reserve categories, NRI Quota seats, etc., may remain vacant after exhausting all candidates of respective category/quota, therefore, any seat of any college may be vacant in 2<sup>nd</sup> round due to shifting/conversion of seats. Hence, it is not mandatory to fill only those choices/preference which are reflected in the vacancy position of seats. So candidates are advised to fill the preference/choices of college/category as per their choice. The seats will be allocated as per availability of seats as per merit cum preference/choice submitted by the candidate.

## SCHEME OF ENTRANCE TEST

(i) DATE OF TEST: **The Test will be conducted on 02-07-2023**

(ii) SCHEME OF TEST

The Test shall have one paper consisting of questions in General Nursing and Midwifery.

The questions will be in English language. The candidate will be required to find out the correct answer and mark it on the Optical Mark Reader (OMR) Response Sheet by darkening the corresponding oval against the serial number of the question with BLACK FINE TIP BALL PEN ONLY provided by the university at the time of test. A sample OMR Response sheet is at [Annexure VII](#).

(iii) Centres for the conduct of PPBNET-2023:

The test shall be conducted at the centers decided by the University. The city/cities, centre/centres shall be intimated by the University.

## CONDUCT OF THE TEST

- (i) The test will be conducted on date/time specified in schedule above.
- (ii) Candidates are required to reach the Test Centre at least 2 hours before the start of test. If the candidates do not report in time they are likely to miss some of the general instructions to be announced in the examination hall.
- (iii) The candidates must show, on demand, the Admit Card for entry in the examination hall. A candidate who does not bring the Admit Card issued by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, will not be admitted to the examination hall under any circumstances by the Centre Superintendent. All candidates and invigilators shall be videographed at the examination centres
- (iv) A seat with the Roll Number will be allotted to each candidate.
- (v) Candidates must find out and occupy their allotted seats after consulting the seating plan displayed at Examination Centre.
- (vii) A candidate who comes after 15 minutes of the commencement of the test shall not be permitted to take the test.
- (viii) A candidate shall not be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any other material except the Admit Card inside the Examination Hall.
- (ix) Calculators, Slide Rules, Log Tables, Electronic Watches with facilities of calculators, cellular phones, pagers or any other electronic devices the use/misuse of which would be adverse to the proper conduct of this Test shall not be allowed inside the Examination Hall. Any candidate in possession of these may be expelled from this Test.

**SUBJECT: Admission To Post Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) for the Session 2021 and Onwards.**

1. The Government of Punjab is pleased to notify the admission criteria to Post Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) Course for the Session 2021 and Onwards in the Government & Private Nursing Colleges affiliated with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in the State of Punjab.
2. All admissions of Govt. Quota seats / Management Quota Seats including NRI Quota seats and any other Seats, whatsoever, in the Government & Private Nursing Institutes shall be based on the merit of Entrance Test. No institution shall select any candidate out of any other source or in any other manner at their own level.
3. The Government of Punjab is pleased to authorize Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (BFUHS) to conduct centralized counselling for admissions, for seats as spelled out at Sr. No. 2, on the basis of marks obtained in Entrance Test, which shall be conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot at the earliest possible and it shall be ensured that the final counseling by the University (BFUHS) shall be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2021 of this year and thereafter, individual Institutions would be at liberty to fill-up vacant seats in the presence of representatives of BFUHS.
4. Eligibility criteria for admission in Government & Private Nursing Institutes for Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course, as spelled out at Sr. No. 2 shall be in accordance with eligibility criteria / qualifications / qualifying criteria as prescribed by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi as well as Punjab Government.
5. After the declaration of the Entrance Test result, the candidates shall apply on the specific proforma for all seats to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, (BFUHS), Faridkot. Admission shall be made by the Admission Committee through a Centralized Counselling by BFUHS, Faridkot on the basis of inter-se merit of Entrance Test.
6. Admissions to Private institutions shall also be governed by the provisions of Para 2 above and also as per the provisions of the "Punjab Private

Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee & Making of Reservations) Act, 2006 "

7. A candidate from reserved Category shall have the right to compete for admission in General / Unreserved category seats as per his/her merit on the day of counselling and candidate so selected shall not be counted towards admission in the reserve category.
8. The schedule of counselling, admission and start of classes shall be in conformity with the schedule laid down by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi / State Government. Fee and other charges for submission of the application and counselling shall be notified by BFUHS as per Government approval.
9. The details of the institutions and category wise seats shall be available on the official website of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot i.e. [www.bfuhs.ac.in](http://www.bfuhs.ac.in).
10. The candidate should be a bonafide resident of Punjab. The resident status of Punjab state shall be taken in terms of Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative reforms (PP-II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3 PP II/9619, dated 6<sup>th</sup> June, 1996, and any further instructions issued by the Department of Personnel, if any, and the same shall be adhered to. *A copy of notification No. 1/3/95-3 PP II/9619, dated 6<sup>th</sup> June, 1996 is enclosed herewith.*

The candidate for Post-Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course shall have to be a Registered Nurse/Mid-wife (RN/MW) with any Nursing council of any State.

In addition the following categories of candidates are also eligible for admission in Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course in Nursing institutes in Punjab:-

- i) Wards of defence personnel posted in Punjab.
- ii) Candidates seeking admissions under NRI category.
- iii) Candidates belonging to minority community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions.
- iv) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central Government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out of the three years preceding year of passing 10+2 examination but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependents have passed class XI and/or XII or equivalent qualifying examinations from outside Punjab. However those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for these three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.
- v) Candidates under J & K migrant for J & K migrant quota seats only.

Provided however, that in case adequate number of candidates are not available for Nursing course, then firstly other States' candidates may be

considered as per Entrance Test merit and there after from Non-Entrance Test candidates. All admissions will be made under the supervision and in the presence of Representative of BFUHS.

11. **ADMISSION COMMITTEES:** In the overall supervision of Vice Chancellor of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, the following committee is constituted for holding counselling and finalizing the admissions:

12. **APPELLATE AUTHORITY:-**

Director, Research and Medical Education, Punjab, shall be the appellate authority in case of any dispute.

13. **FEE**

1. **Government College : Rs. 40,000/- (Per Annum)**  
 2. **University College of Nursing: Rs. 40,000/- (Per Annum)**  
 3. **Private Colleges:**

Total fee to be charged for NRI seats:

- (i) Fee for Indian Nationals - Rs. 50,000/- (Annual)  
 (ii) Fee for NRI's - US\$ 15,000 (Full Course)  
 (iii) Fee for Foreign National - US\$ 15,000 (Full Course)

**NOTE:**

- i) As per notification of Govt. of Punjab, Department of Medical Education and Research (Health-III Branch)-No-11/68/2019=5HB-III/5887 dated 01-10-2020, Fee should be increased annually in Government and Private both institutions by 5% for five years for subsequent batches and fee be reviewed again after 5 years, with rounding off to nearest hundred.
- ii) Tuition fee for 'one year' shall be paid to Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- iii) If candidate is shifted from one College to another in the subsequent Counselling, the fee shall be refunded / adjusted after completion of the admission process. The University shall refund / adjust the fee within 30 days.
- iv) The fee will be payable on 'annual 'basis'. The colleges will not insist for deposit of fee of the entire course in advance.
- (b) Hostel fee and security advance (Annual and provisional) for private institutes. Hostel fee for University Constituents Colleges shall be in terms of Punjab Government letter no-7/107/2012-5553/209 dated 11-02-2015.
- a. Non Air Conditioned Independent Room: Rs.16,500/- per year for the First year (Maximum) for single bedroom. This fee may be hiked by maximum upto 5% for each subsequent year.
- b. Special Room (Attached bathroom and AC) : Rs.26,400/- per year (Maximum). This fee may be hiked by maximum upto 10% for each subsequent year.
- c. Security Advance Rs.27,500/- or its equivalent (refundable in the shape of demand draft.)
- d. Mess charges- Actual and to be managed by the students.
- e. These charges are exclusive of electricity and water charges but inclusive of every other charge. All charges shall be levied from students on six monthly basis.

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**14. (A) Reservation in Government Nursing Colleges :**

The reservation for the State quota seats in Government Institutes in various categories for admission to the Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course in Government Nursing Colleges shall be as under:

(i)	Scheduled Castes	25%
(ii)	Backward Classes	10%
(iii)	Backward Area/ Border Area (1% each)	2%
(iv)	Physically Disabled	5%



- (v) Sports Persons 1%  
Credit shall be given only for the sports achievements made during class XI and XII. The admission shall be made on the basis of inter-se merit of the candidates determined on the basis of gradation (Category A/B/C) issued by the Director of Sports, Punjab. However, for exempted categories under para 12 of this Notification, the competent authority will be Director, Sports of that State or U.T. from where the candidate has passed his class XI and XII examinations.
- (vi) Children/Grandchildren of terrorist affected persons 1%  
Children/Grandchildren of Sikh riot affected persons 1%  
(In order of preference to the exclusion of next category) (Preference shall be given to a candidate whose parent or guardian is killed in such situation - Guardian to be considered only in case neither parent was alive at the relevant time)
- Persons killed in terrorist actions in Punjab/ riots outside Punjab.
  - Terrorist/ Riot affected /displaced persons
- (vii) Wards of Defence Personnel 1%

**Note:-** In order of preference to the exclusion of next category as per letter No.6(1)/2017/D(Res.II) dated 21.05.2018 of Ministry of Defence, Department of Ex-serviceman Welfare, Government of India.

**Note:-** Certificate to this effect must be issued by Army/Navy/ Air Force Headquarters or the Commanding Officer of the Unit, countersigned by the Director, Defence Services Welfare, Punjab in case of the Serving Defence Personnel. In case of Ex-Servicemen certificate should be signed by the concerned District Defence Services Welfare Officer, countersigned by the Director, Defence Services Welfare, Punjab.

- (viii) Wards of Punjab Police Personnel, Punjab Armed Police, Punjab Home Guards and Para-Military Forces (in order of preference to the exclusion of next category) 1%.

Certificate to this effect issued by Inspector General of Police (HQ), Punjab Police shall have to be produced while submitting other documents. In case of Paramilitary Forces this certificate shall be countersigned by IG Police (HQ) Punjab.

- Killed in action
- Disabled in action to the extent of 50%
- Winners of President's Police Medal for Gallantry or Police Medal for Gallantry

- (ix) Children/grandchildren of freedom fighters of Punjab 1%

(B) **Reservation in Private Institutes** (for Government/Management quota seats) shall be as under:

- a) Scheduled Caste 25%
- b) Backward Classes 10%
- c) Physically Disabled 5%
- d) Migrants from Jammu & Kashmir due to terrorist violence. 1%

15. **DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS in PRIVATE COLLEGES:**

A. **Government Quota Seats (50% of the total):**

1.	For candidates who have passed qualifying examination of General Nursing & Midwifery Diploma from any recognized institution situated in the State of Punjab	50% of the total seats.
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B. **Management Quota (50% of the total):**

1.	For candidates who have passed qualifying examination of General Nursing & Midwifery Diploma from any recognized institution situated in the State of Punjab	35% of the total seats.
2.	For NRI/Children of NRI	15% of the total seats.

**NOTE:-**

In the first instance admission to the institutions having valid No Objection Certificate / Essentiality Certificate from Govt. Of Punjab and permission of affiliation from all the statutory bodies, i.e., Punjab Nurses Registration Council (PNRC) / Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (BFUHS) shall be finalized. The institutions which secure these permissions upto 31st October of the corresponding year, shall also be considered.

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16. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-**

For admission in this course(s) the candidate must have scored at least 35% (30% for SC/BC) in entrance test. In case of equal marks in entrance test inter se merit of the candidate for tie breaking in entrance test shall be determined on the basis of age. Older in age kept higher in rank.

- 16.1 Candidate should have obtained certificate in General Nursing and Midwifery from an institution recognized by the Punjab Nursing Registration Council, Indian Nursing Council and situated in the State of Punjab. (The condition of Institute being situated in State of Punjab stands exempted for those covered under exemptions to clause 10.
- 16.2 The candidate will be required to be registered after admission if already not registered with Punjab Nurses Registration Council.
- 16.3 Candidate shall be medically fit.
- 16.4 The selection shall be made as per following manner, subject to the condition that the rules / regulations / guidelines of Indian Nursing Council are strictly followed :-
- (i) From amongst the Entrance Test qualified students on the basis of merit list;
  - (ii) From amongst the Entrance Test appeared students from the State of Punjab.
  - (iii) From amongst the bonafide residents of Punjab State on the basis of merit of qualifying exam;
  - (iv) If, seats still remain vacant, candidates belonging to other State shall also be considered on the basis of qualifying exam.

There shall be no overlapping or bye-passing of inter-se-merit of candidates seeking admission to seats in management quota except NRI quota seats."

- (v) Equal Marks: In case of candidates securing equal marks in entrance test, their inter-se-merit will be determined as under:
  - i) Firstly the candidate having higher percentage of aggregate marks calculated upto 3 decimal points in GNM.
  - ii) Candidate having higher percentage of marks calculated upto 3 decimal points in final GNM.
  - iii) The candidate older in age.

## 17. Non-Resident Indian (NRI) SEATS

15% seats in all Private Nursing Colleges and 7.5% seats in Govt. Nursing Colleges shall be earmarked for the Non-Resident Indians in the following order:

Category I: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to the State of Punjab.

Category II: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to an Indian State other than Punjab.

- (i) Under this policy Non Resident Indian means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:
- (i) for or on taking up employment outside India ; or
  - (ii) for carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
  - (iii) for any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;
- For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India shall be taken into consideration.
- (ii) The eligibility of the candidates shall be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, who shall issue an eligibility certificate to each such candidate.
- (iii) The fee notified for NRI category shall be applicable to NRI candidates getting admission to Govt. Nursing Colleges also.
- (iv) The NRI students shall have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments as provided.
- (v) The Centralized Counselling of NRI quota seats shall be held before the Counselling for other categories. In case of any seat remaining vacant under NRI quota, during / after 2nd Centralized Counselling of NRI quota in State Colleges, it shall go to General category and in the Private Colleges/Minority colleges shall go to General Category of the Management/ Minority quota. The NRI left over seats shall be filled by the same Admission Committee from amongst the eligible candidates of Entrance Test.
- (vi) Vacant seats under NRI Quota will be offered to Foreign Nationals. If these seats can not be filled up from Foreign Nationals then these seats will be diverted to General Category candidates.

**18. Declaration to be submitted by the candidate**

The Candidate and his parent / guardian shall submit a sworn declaration that the candidate has not passed the qualifying examination from more than one Board / University and has not obtained admission in Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course in any other State / UT.

**19. Candidates already admitted:-**

Any candidate, who has taken admission in the previous session in Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course, shall be eligible to seek admission again in the same course, like a fresh applicant based on marks of Entrance Test if permitted by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.

20. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

- a) The University shall display combined merit list of all candidates including reserve category and also a separate merit list of different categories which should be displayed on the University website at least 7 days before the counselling.
- b) The admission shall be made to only those institutes which are approved from all the concerned authorities on or before the first counselling. Institute(s) which has applied for affiliation and/or for approval of competent authority(ies) but are unable to get affiliation and such approval from all the concerned authorities before this day shall not be considered for counselling.
- c) In order to ensure completion of the prescribed courses(s) and period of study as well as commencement of examination(s) in time, no admission(s) adjustment(s) shall be made after 30<sup>th</sup> November, of each year or any other date as may be notified by the Indian Nursing Council.
- d) In case of candidates whose parents are not alive, the dependency certificate shall have to be taken from the Deputy Commissioner / District Collector of the District or any other Government official duly authorized by the State Government or Deputy Commissioner / District Collector where the candidate resides.
- e) The reservation for SC shall be calculated on total seats.
- f) Students claiming benefits of reservation under SC/BC category shall be required to produce a certificate from the competent authority as per latest instructions of Govt. of Punjab. Further, a valid Backward Class Certificate must be produced as per the latest instructions of Department of Welfare, Government of Punjab in which the annual income of the family is clearly mentioned.
- g) Scheduled Caste/ Backward Classes category candidates shall be eligible to apply for Post-Matric Scholarship and reimbursement of fee if they fulfill

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the terms and conditions laid down by Department of Welfare, Govt. of Punjab.

- h) The Reservation of Physically Challenged persons shall be as per the provision of Right of Persons with Disability Act 2016.

Successful handicapped candidates must appear before the Medical Board at Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot on specified date notified by the BFUHS, Faridkot before counselling

- i) Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserve category shall be transferred to the General Category.
- j) For students admitted through online counseling, fee shall be deposited as prescribed by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot after verification of documents. For students admitted through physical counseling, fee shall be deposited through Bank Demand Draft only.
- k) If candidate surrender the seat in-between during the course, then candidate is liable to pay full fee for entire course.
21. The State Government reserves the right to amend any clause and procedure for admission.
22. In case of any doubt, the Administrative Secretary, Department of Medical Education & Research, Government of Punjab may issue clarification which will have force of the policy.
23. For any dispute arising out of this notification or of the admissions under this notification, the Administrative Secretary, Department of Medical Education & Research, Government of Punjab shall be competent to resolve whose decisions shall be final.
24. This notification supersedes all the notifications for admission to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course in the State, issued earlier.

The Governor of Punjab is pleased to notify as per provisions contained in "The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of admission, fixation of fee and making of reservation Act, 2006 (Punjab Act No. 6 of 2006) fee structure for Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (A.N.M) course, Bachelor of Science, Nursing (Basic) course and Bachelor of Science, Nursing (Post Basic) course in Government/Private Medical Colleges as under:-

1. That the fee for government institutions is to be fixed lower than private institutions.
2. GNM course fee should not be revised as the course is expected to be stopped by the Indian Nursing Council from 2021.
3. ANM course fee is to be increased from Rs.5000 per year to Rs.7000 per year in Government institutions, and from Rs.14375 per year to Rs.18000 per year in private institutions.
4. Bachelor of Science, Nursing (Basic) and Bachelor of Science, Nursing (Post Basic) course fee is Rs.40000 per year in Government institutions and no increase is proposed for these; however, in private institutions it is to be increased from Rs.40250 per year to Rs.50000 per year.
5. The fee of Master of Science (Nursing) course in Government institutions is Rs.100000 per year and in private institutions it is Rs.175000 and no increase is to be made in this fee.
6. The increase in fee will be applicable prospectively, i.e. to new students only, joining the new session from 2020-21 onwards. All existing enrolled students will continue to pay at old rates for the full course.
7. It was also decided that fee should be increased annually in Government and Private both institutions by 5% for 5 years for subsequent batches, and fee be reviewed again after 5 years, with rounding off to nearest hundred.
8. The instructions issued in this regard as per Finance Department with their vide letter no. FD-FE-204/3/2020-4FE2/1/67354/2020, dated 24.08.2020 and letter no. FD-FE-201/19/2020-4FE2/1/54970/2020, dated 27.07.2020 will be applicable, which state that Department of Medical Education and Research has been allowed to retain till 31.12.2020 the amount collected as User Charges by institutions coming under its



I am directed to invite your attention to the Punjab Government Circular Letter No.1/3/95-3PP II/2043, dated 29/1/1996 vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for purposes of admission to educational institutions (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgement delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain Vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-4121 wherein it was held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Residence' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government on the subject. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government to revise the Government instructions referred to above as under:

From: Chief Secretary to Government of Punjab to all the Heads of the department etc.

Subject: Issuance of certificate for the purpose of seeking admission to various educational/technical/professional institutions in the state and also for employment.

Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of Government that educational authorities and institutions prescribe various certificates regarding residence, SC/BC category and backward area etc. to be furnished by the students/candidates with the applications forms for entrance examinations or employment in the formats and by the authorities different from those prescribed by the Government departments. Cases have also been reported where the authorities concerned insist on retaining original certificates and refuse to accept the attested photo copies of the certificates. All this results in harassment and panic among the students/candidates and their parents/guardian, since they have to apply with such certificates to more than one authorities simultaneously and within a limited period. The lists of certificates required at the time of applying for CET/PPBNET/PMT and PAU are enclosed by way of illustration.

2. In order to overcome the difficulty mentioned above, it has been decided by the Government that following procedure has been decided by the Government that the following procedure shall be followed meticulously by all the educational and other authorities concerned:-

- i) Certificates issued in the format and by the authorities prescribed by the Government Departments shall be accepted as valid by all educational institutions and other authorities.
- ii) Where a number of authorities have been authorized to issue the certificates there shall be no insistence on issue of a certificate by any particular authority or by the highest authority indicated in the format.
- iii) (a) In case of entrance examinations, no certificate should be called for in the first instance alongwith the application form. It will be sufficient for the candidate seeking admission or other facility to indicate in the application form whether he/she belongs to any particular category entitling him/her to certain concessions or facility. Requisite certificates may be obtained only from the selected/wait listed candidates.
- iii) (b) To further simplify the procedure attested copies of the certificates only shall be retained and original certificates if required to be produced at the time of interview shall be returned immediately, thereafter.
- iv) Parents/guardian or candidates can also obtain SC certificates from the Head of the institution where the candidates has studied if the proof is available in the school records.
- v) The persons who are employed in Government of India or any other State Government are to be treated at par with the employees of the Government of Punjab in the matter of issue of Scheduled Caste certificate provided relevant Scheduled Caste certificate exists in their service record. The Scheduled Caste certificate in such will be issued by the respective Heads of Departments in the Proforma below:-
