It will also give an opportunity to visit the Holy city of Amritsar.

About Amritsar

Popularly believed to have been laid in 1574, the city of Amritsar is one of the most traveled tourist destinations in India. The Golden Temple is the cradle of Amritsar with the city growing around it nurtured by its divine sanctity. For the Sikh community the Harimandir Sahib Gurudwara; Golden Temple is the final spiritual "vision," journey's end or beginning and, for every other community too, it is a shrine to be visited. Amritsar also played a pivotal role in India's quest for independence, and no national monument has more significance than Jalianwala Bagh, a solemn, grim reminder of one of the bloodiest chapters of India's freedom movement. Also worth visiting are the Durgiana Temple (the temple of goddess Durga, established in 16th century) Ram Tirath (birth place of Lav and Kush), and Maharaja Ranjit Singh Museum in Ram Bagh. A popular outing is to the Wagha check post on the Indo-Pakistan border where crowds throng to see the change of guards ceremony and the flag hoisting and lowering, all done with great skill and precision. Amritsar is famous for Cottage Industries like hand embroideries, and work of Zari, tila and Dapka. Local language is Punjabi. The weather in April would be pleasant and light cotton clothes will suffice.

Amritsar is well connected by road, rail and air to the Capital of Centre i.e. New Delhi.
