**Note:** The House noted that the Board of Studies in Medical Sciences (PG) in its meeting held on 26.04.2016, vide para 19 had recommended to the Faculty of Medical Sciences to adopt the General Note, vide which the Medical Council of India, New Delhi amended the Clause 12, Sub-section 4 relating to Assistant Professors as under:

**“For Assistant Professor:-** If an Assistant Professor fulfils all the eligibility criteria for the post of Associate Professor as laid down in the Medical Council of India regulations, namely “Minimum Qualification for Teachers in medical Institutions, Regulations 1998”, and fulfils all the requirement of Postgraduate teacher as per the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, (Amendment), but has not been promoted to the higher post due to administrative non-availability of post or delay in fulfilling up of post in the Govt. organization, if he/she continues to work at the same government organization then such postgraduate teacher shall be allotted 1 (One) postgraduate students.”

**Now the Medical Council of India, New Delhi vide its** Notification No.MCI-18(1)/2016-Med./116133 dated 17.6.2016 has further substituted this note as under:

“If an Assistant Professor fulfils all the requirements of Postgraduate Teacher as per Postgraduate Medical Education Regulation, 2000 as amended, he shall be considered a Postgraduate teacher and shall be allotted 1 (one) Postgraduate student.”

11. Considered the recommendations made by the Board of Studies in Medical Sciences (Postgraduate) in its meeting held on 18.05.2017 vide para-11 and **RESOLVED:** To recommend to the Academic Council for approval that to adopt Notification No.MCI-18(1)/2016-Med./165623 dated 31.01.2017 of Medical Council of India, New Delhi (**Pages 54 to 56 of Appendices**), vide which it has been added the following Clause 12(1) & 12(2) in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000 under the heading "Number of Postgraduate Students to be admitted":

*"Provided that in Public funded Government Medical Colleges the teacher:student ratio shall be 1:3 for Professor an 1:2 for Associate Professor if the Associate Professor is a Unit Head, in all the clinical subjects."*

Also considered the recommendations and it was further **RESOLVED:** To recommend to the Academic Council for approval that in view of the above notification regarding enhanced teacher:student ratio the Student:Guide ratio, which was approved by the Board of Management in its meeting held on 25.08.2011, vide para 25, be amended as follows to be applicable in public funded Government Medical Colleges only w.e.f. the academic session 2017-18. However, there will be no change in student:guide ratio in the private Medical Colleges:





