About Faridkot:

Faridkot town is believed to be founded and named as Mokhalhar in the 12th Century by Raja Mohalsi (also called Mokhal Dev), the 9th Descendant of Manjh from the clan of Jaisal Bhatti Rajput- who founded Jaisalmer. In the 13th century, the famous Sufi Saint Hazrat Baba Sheikh Farid on his way to Pakpattan (now in Pakistan) from Delhi happened to pass through this Princely State and caught by the man of raja Mokhal Dev. The Baba Farid pardoned the Raja and meditated at a place near the Fort, now Known as "Tilla Baba Farid" where he penanced for 40 days before proceeding to Pakpattan(now in Pakistan). From that day the name of Mokalkhar was changed to Faridkot with the permission of sufi – saint Baba Farid Ji. The city, Faridkot is one of the district of Punjab, located in Malwa region. The sites worth seeing are, Tilla Baba Farid ji, Gurudwara Godri Sahib, Traditional Fort, Indo Pakistan Border, Hussainiwala (35 Kms from Faridkot)

Paper Submission Criteria

- Abstract should be minimum of 200 – 250 words type in double space and should be submitted in MS word format * docx, font Times Roman, size 12.
- In addition, the authors are required to submit up to five keywords and key phrases with regard to the abstract.
- Only e-mailed abstracts will be accepted.
- E-mail abstract to pafmatcon2015@gmail.com with email subject must begin with – "ABSTRACT SUBMISSION".
- Type of Presentation: Oral or Poster Title: Should be bold with first letter of each word in capitals.
- Author's name/s and affiliation: Should be in capital letters. Name of the presenting author being underlined, followed by Institutional affiliations and e-mail address of the presenting author.
- Contents: Should include the aim of the study, materials & methods, results, conclusions and key words. References, tables graphs or pictures are not to be included in the abstract
- No abstract will be accepted after 31th July 2015
- Abstracts submitted should not be published or presented previously & undertaking in this regard should be attached.
- Scientific committee reserves the right to review and select the scientific papers for oral or poster presentation.

- All abstracts will be reviewed and presenting authors will be informed by e-mail regarding acceptance of their abstract till 15st August 2015.

Technical information for Oral and Poster session:

Oral Presentation: Only Power point presentations will be allowed. The time limit for oral presentations will be 6 minutes followed by discussions for 2 minutes.

Poster Presentation: Size of the posters should not exceed 4*3 feet. Best Oral and Poster presentation in the three different categories (Faculty, PGT and UG students).
