

## **Admission Notice for NRI seats in Post Graduate Courses, Session 2018**

The following procedure of admission is as per Punjab Government Notification No. 5/26/2016-5HB-III/557 dated 25.01.2018.

1. The Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare vide Notification no. V.11025/05/2017-MEP dated 27.04.2018 has revised the minimum qualifying percentile for NEET PG courses 2018 i.e General-262 marks (35<sup>th</sup> percentile).
2. **Applications are invited upto 05.05.2018 as per revised qualifying percentile only from candidates becoming eligible after revised percentile.**
3. The admission to NRI seats shall be on the basis of merit in NEET-PG-2018.
4. Application form for issuing of Eligibility/ Equivalency certificate is available from the University counter OR can be downloaded from University website ([www.bfuhs.ac.in](http://www.bfuhs.ac.in)).
5. **Eligibility**
  - \* NRI who passed MBBS
  - \* Must have completed internship by 31-3-2018
  - \* Must be qualified- NEET-PG-2018
6. After getting Eligibility/ Equivalency certificate, candidate has to apply on prescribed application form upto **05.05.2018 by 5.00 PM** to the University for Counselling for admission to MD/MS/PG Diploma Courses under NRI quota in Private colleges for session 2018.
7. Candidate must be registered with MCI/State Medical and must have recognition Certificate of MBBS Equivalent Degree from MCI.
8. Punjab Govt. vide its Notification no.5/26/2016-5HB-III/557 dated 25.01.2018 has notified that 15% seats of total seats are reserved for NRI's in PG courses at Private colleges in order to preference as under:

Category I : NRIs/Children of NRI who originally belonged to State of Punjab  
Category II : NRIs /Children of NRI who originally belonged to an Indian state other than Punjab

- (a) Under this policy Non Resident Indian Means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:
- (i) For or on taking up employment outside India ; or
  - (ii) For carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
  - (iii) For any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign Country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India Shall be taken into consideration.

9. Fee Structure for NRI candidates (**As per Notification Govt. of Punjab.**):

Fee may be paid in lump sum or installment as given below:

1. Selected candidates will have to deposit full /1<sup>st</sup> installment of the fee on the spot.
2. The payment in shape of Demand Draft should be in favour of **Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.**
3. The payment should either be in US \$ or is drawn from their own or parents NRE account along with bank certificate/statement showing that payment is drawn from candidate or parents account.

**Note: Registration /continuation fee @ 15% of tuition fee will be charged from NRI candidates who will be admitted.**
