The Medical Council of India, New Delhi vide notification No. MCI-34(41)/2018-Med./109835 dated 18.05.2018 imposed the following penalty clause for the candidates who will surrender / not joined the seat after 2nd round of counselling :

Keeping in view the above situation and to avoid seat blocking, the following are the instructions for immediate compliance by the candidates to be eligible for 2nd round:

1. The candidates including those who have already joined in 1st round of counseling shall submit the willingness to participate in the 2nd round of online State counselling on university website.
2. The following is the refundable / adjustable registration deposit alongwith conditions for various seats in Govt. as well as private Medical/Dental colleges of State of Punjab :

Sr. No.	Preference of submitting the choice in various colleges	Refundable Registration to be deposited.
1.	For submitting the choices/preferences for Govt. colleges only	Rs. 10000/-
2.	For submitting the choices/preferences for Private Colleges, both Govt. colleges and Private Colleges including Minority institutions/ Private universities	Rs. 1,00,000/-

Note: The candidates who do not get any seat during 2nd round of counselling, their refundable security deposit will be refunded after completion of admission process.

3. The candidates who have already deposited the fee after provisional selection in 1st round of counselling over and above the penalty amount, shall not be required to deposit the refundable registration fee for 2nd counselling. However, it is mandatory to submit willingness to participate in 2nd round of online counseling.
4. The candidates shall deposit the refundable registration fee through online gateway system available on University website by logging on their ID.
5. For submitting the willingness for 2nd Round by the registered NEET UG-2020 aspirants, the applicant shall log into his/her ID generated at the time of registration.
6. Due to non-joining/surrender of seats after 1st round of counseling, the resultant vacant seats will be displayed on the University website on the date of filling choices/preferences for 2nd round of online counseling.
7. The vacancy position of seats will also be displayed as and when the All India Quota seats will be reverted to State by DGHS, New Delhi to enable candidates to fill choices/preferences during 2nd round of online counseling.
8. The process of inviting willingness for 2nd round of online counseling will start w.e.f. 05.12.2020 till further orders.

भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद्,
संशोधन अधिसूचना

सं.भा.आ.प.-34(41)/2018-मेड./109835.—भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद् अधिनियम, 1956 (1956 का 102) की धारा 33 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का इस्तेमाल करते हुए, भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद् "स्नातक चिकित्सा शिक्षा विनियमावली, 1997" में पुनः संशोधन करने के लिए, केंद्र सरकार की पूर्व स्वीकृति से निम्नलिखित विनियम बनाती है, नामतः-

- (i) इन विनियमों को "स्नातक चिकित्सा शिक्षा (संशोधन) विनियमावली, 2018" कहा जाएगा
(ii) ये सरकारी राजपत्र में उनके प्रकाशन की तारीख से प्रवृत्त होंगे
- "स्नातक चिकित्सा शिक्षा विनियमावली, 1997" में 5क (3) के पश्चात् निम्नलिखित खंड जोड़ा जाएगा:-
"5 क (4) - एमबीबीएस पाठ्यक्रम में दाखिले के लिए सामूहिक काउंसिलिंग में सीट ब्लॉकिंग रोकने और काउंसिलिंग के दौरान नया विकल्प चुनने की अनुमति की दृष्टि से, शुल्क की जवती, "परिशिष्ट - च" में दिए गए मापदंडों के अनुसार होगी।"
- "स्नातक चिकित्सा शिक्षा विनियमावली, 1997" के, परिशिष्ट - च में, शैक्षिक वर्ष 2018-19 के लिए और उसके पश्चात्, प्रथम एमबीबीएस पाठ्यक्रम हेतु दाखिला प्रक्रिया की पूर्णता की समय अनुसूची के नीचे निम्नलिखित "टिप्पणी" जोड़ी जाएगी:-

टिप्पणी:

- वर्तमान दाखिला वर्ष के कार्य आरंभ की अंतिम तारीख अर्थात् 22 जुलाई के पश्चात् खाली रही अखिल भारतीय कोटा सीटें (15%), राज्य कोटे में परिवर्तित मानी जाएंगी।

2. 31 मई के पश्चात अनुमति प्राप्त संस्थान/कालेज/पाठ्यक्रमों पर, चालू शैक्षिक वर्ष के लिए दाखिले/सीटों के आवंटन हेतु विचार नहीं किया जाएगा।
3. किसी भी परिस्थिति में, दाखिले/कार्य आरंभ की अंतिम तारीख, 31 अगस्त के पश्चात नहीं बढ़ाई जाएगी।
4. उपर्युक्त समय अनुसूची का निष्ठापूर्वक अनुपालन सुनिश्चित करने के उद्देश्य के लिए, शनिवार, रविवार या अवकाशों, (15 अगस्त स्वतंत्रता दिवस के कारण राष्ट्रीय अवकाश को छोड़कर) को कार्य दिवस माना जाएगा।
5. काउंसिलिंग के दौरान नया विकल्प चुनने के लिए छात्रों को अनुमेयता के संबंध में निम्नलिखित मापदंड लागू होंगे:-

AMENDMENT NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, the 18th May, 2018

No.MCI-34(41)/2018-Med./109835.— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 33 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956), the Medical Council of India with the previous sanction of the Central Government,

hereby makes the following Regulations to further amend the "Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997", namely: -

1. (i) These Regulations may be called the "Regulations on Graduate Medical Education (Amendment), 2018.
(ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the "Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997", following clause shall be added after 5A(3):-
5A(4) - In order to prevent seat blocking in common counseling for admission to MBBS course and permissibility to exercise fresh choice during counseling, forfeiture of fee shall be in accordance with the Matrix contained in "Appendix - F".
3. In the "Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997", in Appendix "F" the following "Note" shall be added below the Time Schedule for completion of the admission process for first MBBS course for the academic year 2018-19 and onwards: -

Note:

1. All India Quota Seats (15%) remaining vacant after last date for joining, i.e. 22nd July of the present Admission year will be deemed to be converted into State quota.
2. Institute/college/courses permitted after 31st May will not be considered for admission/ allotment of seats for current academic year.
3. In any circumstances, last date for admission/joining will not be extended after 31st August.
4. For the purpose of ensuring faithful obedience to the above time-schedule, Saturday, Sunday or Holidays (except National Holiday on account of Independence Day, 15th August) shall be treated as working days.
5. The following Matrix shall be applicable with regard to permissibility to students to exercise fresh choice during counseling:-

6. As per MCI regulations, DGHS counseling would include AIQ seats. Central Institutions and Deemed Universities. State/UT counseling would include State Quota seats and all private colleges in the States/UTs.
