

The ECFMG® certification process includes qualitative elements such as English language skills, medical note writing abilities, and professional manners. The AMRCB® certification conference supplements from the ECFMG® certification to also include training and evaluation on professionalism; presentations skills; the ability to apply information and knowledge; attention to detail; communication skills; motivation; organization, and the ability to relate to people. The AMRCB® emphasizes the concept that professional skills are the foundation of success not only in the field of medicine, but in every successful organization. AMRCB® certification is designed to aid international graduates who seek to be distinguished from the large pool of yearly applicants for internship and residency positions, and for those who want to achieve a mark of excellence.

Upon successful completion of AMRCB® Resident Certification Conference attendees receive a qualitative assessment and are ranked among those who have completed the conference. A transcript of the educational scores and assessments are available to the student and are sent, upon request, to individual U.S., Canadian, and international medical residencies and other organizations as well.







Understanding the basics about the healthcare delivery system in the United States is paramount in order to practice medicine within the U.S. This understanding is also necessary during the interview process for residencies. During these dynamic changes in the U.S. healthcare industry, it is extremely important to understand the current events when interacting with patients, fellow physicians, attending physicians, and employers.

Studying to be a Practicing Doctor in USA

Not all doctors are created equal; learn what is required and expected of the successful licensed and practicing physician in the United States.

US Practices and Customs

International medical graduates must understand the proper customs and etiquettes expected within the United States. Effective interaction with patients, colleagues, and employers is necessary in order to earn their trust and respect.

Breakout Sessions

Who Am I and What Do I Offer or Contribute?

An "Elevator Speech" is a rehearsed presentation that describes who you are as an individual, what skill sets you have, and how you will benefit future organizations. An effective "Elevator Speech" is presented in two to three minutes or less. This is a necessary tool in order to become noticed and eventually selected by future organizations. Applicants will learn to build this "Elevator Speech" throughout the course.

Why Should You Pick Me?

Continuation of the "Elevator Speech" to convince an interviewing panel that you are the one that should be selected for the residency.

Why I Want To Practice in the United States (or elsewhere)?

Last section of your "Elevator Speech" to let Residency Selection Members know why you wish to practice Medicine in a particular country.

Professionalism / Motivation

Proper appearance, dress code, hygiene, and attitude are needed for success in any corporate setting. These attributes will be defined and reviewed.

Presentation Skills

Saying what you need to say in the shortest amount of time, without losing your audience's attention, is a necessary skill. Lengthy discussions involving tone, speed, and clarity of speech will be discussed.

Strengths & Weaknesses Exercise

Be prepared to discuss your strong and weak points that you feel you know about yourself. Your partner / colleague will actively listen and then give you constructive criticism about your two minute speech.

Elevator Speech Rehearsal

Your formal three to five minute Elevator Speech will be rehearsed with constructive criticism from your colleagues. This rehearsal speech will be video taped and played back so you can watch your own speech as an active listener. Observe your talking style, speed, eye contact, manner of speaking, hand gestures, etc.
