NOTICE

This is for the information of NEET UG-2020 aspirants for admission to MBBS/BDS Courses that the provisionally allotted candidate of Round II shall submit their joining in the provisionally allotted college upto 21.12.2020 (05:00 PM). In case the allotted candidate does not report to the provisionally allotted college within stipulated date and time his/her security amount will be forfeited as per Notification No. MCI-34(41)/2018-Med./109835 dated 18.05.2018 issued by the Medical Council of India, New Delhi.

Note 1: Round I joined candidate who has not been upgraded in Round II may resign his/her allotted seat of Round-I till 21.12.2020 (upto 05:00 pm) with forfeiture. In case the candidate does not surrender the seat within the given time frame he/she will be considered as joined as per Question No. 37 of FAQ which is reproduced below:

“Q No. 37: Who are eligible for “Exit with Forfeiture” option?”

Ans. Candidate who has been allotted a seat in Round II but does not report at the college may exit with Forfeiture (i.e. the refundable security amount will not be refunded in such case).

a) Round I joined candidate who has not been Upgraded in Round II may resign his seat allotted in Round I within two days of Round II Result announcement failing which he will be considered as part of joined candidates for Round II and rules will apply accordingly and such candidate will not be allowed.”

Such candidate will not be allowed to vacate the seat afterwards and rules will apply as per Notification No. MCI-34(41)/2018-Med./109835 dated 18.05.2018 issued by the Medical Council of India, New Delhi.

Note 2: Candidate whose seat has been upgraded in Round II will collect his/her original documents from the provisionally allotted college during Round I and submit original documents for checking eligibility and verification to the Principal of the College where shifted during Round II.
