

PROCEDURE FOR SEEKING ADMISSION TO MBBS/BDS COURSES UNDER FOREIGN INDIAN STUDENTS (NRI) QUOTA AFFILIATED TO THE BABA FARID UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, FARIDKOT/PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES/MINORITY INSTITUTIONS, PUNJAB(INDIA)
SESSION – 2022

The following procedure of admission is as per Punjab Government notification no.5/5/2021-5HB-III/2221 dated 22.08.2022. Relevant clauses of notification are as under:

Clause 2

All admissions of Govt. Quota seats/Management Quota Seats, including NRI and any Minority Quota seats, and any other Seats, whatsoever, in the Government & Private Medical/Dental Institutes, including Institutes under Private Universities and Minority Institutions shall be based on the merit of National Eligibility-cum –Entrance Test (NEET)

Clause-17

15% seats in all private Institutes/Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot and 13 seats each in Govt. Medical College, Patiala and Amritsar and 15 seats in Dr. B.R.Ambedkar State Institute of Medical Sciences, Mohali and 3 seats in Govt. Dental College, Amritsar and 4 seats in Govt. Dental College, Patiala shall be earmarked for the Non Resident Indians in the following order:

Category I: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to the State of Punjab.

Category II:NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to an Indian State other than Punjab.

- (I) Under this policy Non Resident Indian Means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:
- (i) For or on taking up employment outside India ; or
 - (ii) For carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
 - (iii) For any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign Country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India Shall be taken into consideration.

Introduction:

1. Candidate must have qualified NEET UG-2022.
2. After getting provisional Eligibility/Equivalency certificate from BFUHS, Faridkot, candidate has to apply on prescribed application from upto **17.10.2022** to BFUHS, Faridkot for Counseling for admission to MBBS/BDS courses under NRI quota in Govt./ University/ Private Universities/Private Colleges.

3. Eligibility criteria for admission to MBBS/BDS courses under NRI quota seats shall be in accordance with eligibility criteria/qualification /qualifying criteria as prescribed in the Information Bulletin for National Eligibility –cum-Entrance Test (NEET) issued by CBSE for the corresponding year.
4. All applications for equation are required to be sent to the University at its official address Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Sadiq Road, Faridkot 151203 (Pb.), INDIA on or before the last date.
5. Admission shall be strictly according to preference category wise merit as per the Punjab Govt. Notification and its amendments. After selection, the candidates will be required to deposit the prescribed fee as per instructions.
6. For specific last dates for submitting applications and date of counselling and other information please keep yourself updated by visiting our University website www.bfuhs.ac.in from time to time.

Procedure for getting Eligibility Certificate

Before applying for admission under Foreign Indian Student(NRI) quota a candidate needs to seek Equivalence/Eligibility certificate from BFUHS by applying on prescribed application performa available on University website www.bfuhs.ac.in and it may be sent to the University alongwith fee of **US\$ 1000 or its equivalent amount in Indian Rupees plus Rs 1000/- or equivalent in US\$** being the cost of the application form in the shape of demand draft/cashier's cheque in favour of the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable in India.

The applicant has to attach following documents along with the application:-

- (i) NEET UG -2022 result and Admit card.
- (ii) 10+1/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
(The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (iii) 10+2/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
(The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (iv) Explanation Sheet of grades.
- (v) Pass Certificate/Diploma of 10+2 or equivalent examination.
- (vi) Proof of Accreditation of School in case candidate pass his/her 10+2 or equivalent examination from institution situated in U.S.A
- (vii) Detail of Grades of Qualifying examination.
- (viii) Date of Birth Certificate/matriculation (10th) certificate.
- (ix) Character/Recommendation Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- (x) Proof of NRI status of candidate/parents

Note:- These documents should be original along with photocopies duly attested by a competent authority.

After verification of the documents, the university will issue Eligibility/Equivalency Certificate to the Eligible candidates only, and all original documents will be returned in person at the time of issue of Eligibility/Equivalency certificate.

2. Procedure for admission to State/University/Private Universities/Private colleges

- * After getting the Eligibility Certificate from the University, the candidate has to apply for admission on the prescribed Admission Application form to the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- * The candidate can also download Admission Application form from the website of the University www.bfuhs.ac.in. site, he/she will have to send a demand draft of US \$ 1000/- or its equivalent amount in India rupees plus a demand draft of **Rs.2000/- or equivalent in US \$** in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable at Faridkot towards the cost of this form.

Last date for receipt of admission application form at University counter is 17.10.2022.

The candidate has to attach the photocopies of the following documents duly attested by the competent authority along with application form:-

- (i) NEET-2022 Admit Card and NEET-2022 Result Card.
- (ii) 10+1/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
(The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (iii) 10+2/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
(The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (iv) Copy of certificate of qualifying examination (Certificate/Diploma)
- (v) Explanation Sheet of grades.
- (vi) Date of Birth Certificate.
- (vii) Character/Recommendation Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- (viii) Eligibility certificate issued by the Baba Farid University, Faridkot.
- (ix) Three latest colour signed and attested photographs (Passport size).
- (x) The candidate applying under category (I) & (II) are required to submit
 - a. Photostat Copies of the passport of Father/Candidate.
 - b. Proof of having ancestral background of Punjab/Other State.
- (xi) Demand Draft for US \$ 1000 or equivalent in Indian Rupee.
- (xii) Provisional Student Visa, if required.

Eligibility criteria

- a) Candidates must have qualified National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET-2022) for admission to MBBS/BDS courses under NRI quota.
- b) Age as per NEET-2022.
- c) Eligibility criteria for admission to MBBS/BDS courses under NRI quota seats shall be in accordance with eligibility criteria/qualification /qualifying criteria as prescribed in the Information Bulletin for National Eligibility –cum-Entrance Test (NEET) issued by CBSE for the corresponding year.

Preference- :

The criteria laid down for admission against seats reserved for NRI Candidates will be as under:-

Category I : NRIs who originally belong to the State of Punjab.

Category II : NRIs who originally belong to an Indian state other than Punjab.

- (a) The student will have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the residual fee, if he/she opts to pay the fee in installment as provided.
- (b) Selected Candidates will have to deposit full/1st installment of the fee on the spot at the allotted college.
- (c) The payment in shape of Demand Draft should be in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- (b) The payment should either be in US \$ or is drawn from their own or parents NRE account along with bank certificate/statement showing that payment is drawn from candidate or parents account.

3. Candidates must have 'Provisional Student Visa' from the Indian Mission abroad before admission and once he/she gets the confirmed admission, 'Student Visa' can be obtained from FRO/FRRO, on their own.
4. Candidates shall also be required to obtain a Clearance Certificate from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi in due course and submit it to the Principal of the college to which they are admitted.
