SUBJECT: Admission to MBBS/ BDS Courses- in Medical and Dental Institutes in the State of Punjab for the Session 2025 onwards.

In continuation of this Department's Notification No. No.(e723871) MER-HTH305C/9/2024-5HB3/712 dated 09/08/2024and with a view to remove ambiguity in the matter of admission in private medical colleges/universities, the following clarification is hereby issued with respect to Clause 16(x):

1. Clarification of Clause 16(x) - Admission to Private Institutes/Universities:

The existing Clause 16(x) of the Notification reads as under:

"Migrants from Jammu & Kashmir due to terrorist violence – 1% (under admission to private medical colleges/universities)."

It is hereby clarified that:

"Out of the 1% seats reserved in private medical colleges/universities for Migrants from Jammu & Kashmir due to terrorist violence, first preference shall be given to candidates who fulfil both the criteria mentioned in Clause 11 of the original Notification as well as belong to the category of J&K Migrants.

Second preference shall be given to candidates who are J&K Migrants but do not fulfil the criteria specified in Clause 11 of the original Notification."

2. Effect of Clarification:

This clarification shall be read as part of Clause 16(x) of the original Notification and shall not be construed as a change in policy, but only as an explanation of the manner in which the said clause is to be applied.

3. All other provisions of the original Notification shall remain unchanged.
