- vi) The admission shall be done as per criteria fixed by the Punjab Government from time to time.
- vii) The Punjab Government will have the right to withdraw the N.O.C if the Society/applicant fails to meet any of the conditions of N.O.C
- viii) The validity period of this N.O.C will be two years.







At present, the candidates are eligible for Ph.D under Allied Health Sciences Category-D who have passed the Post Graduation Degree other than Medical, Dental, Nursing, and Physiotherapy subject.

1. The candidates other than Medical Post Graduation in any subject can be considered eligible to register for the Ph.D degree in BFUHS under the Medical faculty in the Allied sciences group if they have obtained 55% marks in the concerned Post Graduation.

2. Such eligible candidates can be registered with recognized guide in any of the approved department of affiliated colleges with BFUHS.

The candidates who have obtained the following Master's Degree with 55 % will be eligible to register for Ph.D course and will be allowed to do research work in the Departments mentioned in columns.

Hence, the revised Ordinances and Syllabus is enclosed at (Pages 1 to 10 of Appendices).
- (ii) : The Post Doctoral Certificate Course in Pain Management will be started after obtaining approval from the various authorities i.e. Board of Studies/Faculty/Academic Council and Board of Management and the admission will be made thereafter by the University.

Ordinance for Post-Doctoral Certificate Course in Pain Management

Course coordinator: A University faculty with PDCC qualification in pain management and with atleast 8 years' experience in interventional pain management after passing PDCC in a MCI recognized teaching institution.

1. **Eligibility of the candidates for registration to the Post-Doctoral Certificate Course**
 - (a) Medical graduates holding MD/DNB degree in anesthesiology or its equivalent recognized by the MCI.
 - (b) Maximum age 45 years.
 - (c) One seat will be reserved for in-service candidate. In case, in-service candidate is not available, the seat will be offered in open merit.

2. **Admission & Number of Seats**
 - (a) Admission will be made by the University by conducting an entrance test.
 - (b) Maximum of three candidates will be admitted in a batch/per year (One for in-service candidate on deputation)
 - (c) Minimum one candidate will be needed to start and maintain the PDCC.

3. **Period of Study**
 - (a) The candidate will have to undergo a specified period of study for duration of one year under a chronic pain management coordinator who will be PDCC in the specialty of pain.
 - (b) During the period of study if the candidate has absented himself/herself on any account (except prescribed Institute holidays and casual leaves) for more than a total of 2 months, his/her period of training will be extended by six months. In case the absence is more than a total of 4 months, the period of training will be extended by 1 year. In case the absence is for more than 6 months his/her Admission/registration may be cancelled.
 - (c) Private Practice of any sort is strictly prohibited during the period of course/training.
 - (d) Candidates will be allowed to use the library facilities of the institute.
 - (e) They will be put on regular and emergency duties in the specialties of chronic pain.
 - (f) There will be no thesis for them. But they will have to maintain records of Cases (Log book) done by them and publish one paper in PubMed indexed journals.
 - (g) The selected candidate, whenever required, will also have to provide anaesthesia related services of the center/Institute on rotatory basis apart from training in pain management.

- 4. Fee schedule
 - i. Admission Fee : As per existing University rules for PG courses
 - ii. Registration Fee (payable at the Time of admission) : As per University rules for PG courses
 - iii. Library and other fees : As applicable to the postgraduate courses/ Super-specialty courses
 - iv. Examination fee : As per University rules for PG courses
- 5. Courses of Study : As given in Annexure

6. Stipend and accommodation

Stipend to the candidates as per policy of the Institution equivalent to that of Senior Resident.

No stipend for in-service candidates

Accommodation will be provided if available.

7. Examination

- 1. Examination will be held after completion of the tenure.
- 2. No candidate will be permitted to appear at the examination unless he/she has successfully completed the training period as specified earlier, logbook completed and accepted one paper in PubMed indexed journal during this period.
- 3. The examination will consist of two parts:

- Part I - Theory

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I – Theory

- (i) The examination shall consist of 3 papers – each of three hours duration.
- (ii) There shall be one external and two internal examiners.

II – Oral/Practical/Clinical including Log Book

- (i) There shall be one external and one internal examiner.
- (ii) All the examiners will be severally and jointly responsible for all Parts of the examinations. In pursuance of this the internal examiner shall make necessary arrangements for this examination.
- (iii) The candidate shall present to the examiners, the log book of his Work duly certified by the Head of the Department.

III– Marks : Total Maximum Marks: 600

Theory	:	100 maximum marks of each paper (Total of 300 marks)
Practical/Viva-voce	:	200 marks
Internal Assessment	:	100 marks

IV – Results

- (i) The examiners concerned shall confer at the termination of the examination and the result declared on the overall performance of the candidate in Theory, Practical and/or Clinical, Oral and assessment of the log book. The candidates must obtain a minimum of 50% marks separately each in Theory and Practical/Viva-Voice/Internal Assessment/log book to pass the examination. The examiners shall report whether the candidate has passed or failed.
- (ii) The certificate for the Post-Doctoral Courses shall be awarded to the candidate after the candidate has passed the prescribed examination.

Scheme of Examination

- Theory : There shall be 3 papers of 3 hours duration each
- Paper I : Basic Sciences as applied to the specialty concerned
- Paper II : Clinical Aspects of the specialty concerned

EXAMINER'S PANEL for one year PDCC examination should consists of :

- (i) One internal examiner: Must have one year PDCC training and qualification in pain management from Indian universities and MCI recognized institutions.
- (ii) One external examiner: PDCC qualified (Professor/associate professor) or non PDCC course coordinator.
- (iii) Rule for the moderation of question papers: The moderation of the question papers shall be done as per the University rules.

GENERAL RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE EXAMINATIONS

The same rules as mentioned in the University ordinances for the Conduct of Postgraduate Examinations shall be applicable.

CITATION

The present study was aimed to screen the North Western Punjabi menopausal women for evaluating the prevalence of cardiovascular disease (CVD). It was revealed that a strong association prevailed between the various conventional risk factors and genetic factors. A direct association was observed between *ADIPOQ* (+276G>T) gene polymorphism and various conventional risk factors (both environmental and metabolic). Menopausal women who were homozygous to T allele at position +276 of *AdipoQ* gene were at higher risk of CVD than carriers of G allele. *PPAR γ* (Pro12Ala) gene polymorphism did not show a direct association with various risk factors. However, Pro12Ala of *PPAR γ* gene along with oxidative stress was observed to be an early predictor of cardiovascular events. This study if extended to greater population can prove of public interest in lowering the prevalence of CVD in menopausal women by adopting various life style modifications and assessment of the early predictors of cardiovascular events.

Topic: Growth status of adolescent girls at the age of onset of menarche.

PRATIBHA has investigated and prepared statistically treated data on the growth parameters of Bania girls of Punjab as they enter their age of menarche i.e. onset of menstrual cycles. For this, she not only took linear measurements of these girls but also examined the emergence of teeth in the oral cavity, examined the secondary sex characteristics and took radiographs of the hand and wrist region to find out the status of growth. Her findings provide data which help other research workers and clinicians to better understand the relationship of menarche to growth parameters of adolescent girls. The growth data provided is an indicator of menarcheal status of adolescent Bania girls and helps to understand the growth processes clearly in racially and environmentally homogeneous populations.

VIKAS GUPTA has isolated six flavonoid compounds from the leaves of different varieties of *Citrus paradisi* having anti-anxiety activity. His study has also provided parameters for identification and differentiation within the four varieties. This can help in checking adulteration and substitution of any of these four varieties and help in standardization of herbal formulations. His findings also help the researchers in development of economic safe anti-anxiety formulation from leaf extracts of grapefruit. This the study indicates that iron acts as a double-edged sword having role in carcinogenesis both in low and high concentrations. In premenopausal patients iron was found to be significantly lower as compared to controls indicating the role of low iron in the process of carcinogenesis via pro-angiogenic factors like VEGF and basic fibroblast growth factors which increase the risk of cancer. Ferritin was also found to be lower in premenopausal patients as compared to controls as it is an iron storage protein and low iron levels indicate low ferritin. But in case of postmenopausal women both iron and ferritin were found to be significantly higher in patients as compared to controls. High iron levels leads to increase in oxidative stress through generation of free radicals via Fentons/Habberweiss reaction. Besides this total antioxidant status was found to be significantly lower in both premenopausal and postmenopausal patients as compared to controls. Decreased total antioxidant status results in DNA damage and it forms DNA adducts that activates oncogene induced tumorigenesis and cancer. The Oestradiol levels were found to be higher in both premenopausal and postmenopausal patients as compared to controls indicating genotoxic effects of this hormone caused by increased mitotic rate of breast epithelial cells.

BEAM MODELING OF TELECOBALT UNIT FOR THE DOSE VERIFICATION BY USING MONTE CARLO TECHNIQUE

- Rahul Shukla has modeled the telecobalt unit and generated dose profiles in different plane; his study also provides parameter for 0.5 cc ion chamber dosimetry and inters comparison between various algorithms. The code EGSnrc/BEAMnrc, which is used in our study to simulate Theratron Equinox-80 telecobalt unit is found to generate those information which is very difficult to get from the experiments for example mean energy, angular distribution of radiation etc.
- The simulation of homogenous as well as heterogeneous virtual phantom gives information regarding beam attenuation, which is very important to know when we are actually treating the patients.
- The knowledge gained by this study will help to simulate other radiation generating machines like linear accelerators, which can deliver not only photon beam but electrons too.
- Monte Carlo simulation study on the effectiveness of electron filters designed for the Co-60 beam will help to reduce skin dose, when implemented for the patient treatment and similar study can be initiated for other photon beam energies useful for the radiotherapy treatment.
