## Procedure for seeking admission to B.Sc courses under Foreign Indian Students (NRI) Quota,

Session - 2020

## Introduction:

Candidates seeking admission under the Foreign Indian Students (NRI) category at Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot in *B.Sc Ophthalmic Techniques, Medical Radiography & Imaging Technology, Radiotherapy, Orthopedic Assistant & Plaster Techniques, Operation Theatre Technology, Dialysis Technician, Anesthesia Technology, Emergency Responder, Intensive Care Unit Technology courses having cleared 10+2 school qualification in appropriate subjects from any institution/ university/ board etc. recognized and approved by the Government are eligible to apply. Applicants are required to first apply to the University on prescribed forms for issue of Eligibility Certificate. After obtaining the Eligibility Certificate, candidates are required to apply afresh. Applications are required to be sent to the University at its official address: Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Sadiq Road, Faridkot 151203 (Pb.), INDIA on or before the last date of receiving applications. The physical presence of the candidates is compulsory at the time of Counseling. Admission shall be strictly in accordance with preference category wise merit as per the University norms. After selection, the candidates will be required to deposit the prescribed fee as per instructions. ## 1. <u>Procedure for getting Eligibility Certificate</u>

Before applying for admission under Foreign Indian Student(NRI) quota, a candidate needs to seek Equivalence/Eligibility certificate from BFUHS. Candidate shall apply in prescribed application proforma available on official website i.e. <a href="www.bfuhs.ac.in">www.bfuhs.ac.in</a>. Application shall be sent to the University alongwith processing fee of **US\$ 200 for seeking eligibility certificate for** B.Sc courses plus Rs. 1000/- or **US\$ 25 as** application fee or equivalent amount in Indian rupees in the shape of demand draft in favour of the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any Bank payable in India.

The applicant has to attach following documents along with the application (Check list):-

- (i) Date of Birth Certificate.
- (ii) 10+1/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s) (The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (iii) 10+2/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s) (The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (iv) Explanation Sheet of grades.
- (v) Character/Recommendation Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- (vi) Certificate/Degree/Diploma having passed qualifying examination as a regular candidate from the recognized institution /university.
- (vii) Proof of NRI status of candidate/parents

**Note**:- These documents shall be in original along with photocopies self attested.

After verification of the documents, the university will issue Eligibility/Equivalency Certificate to the Eligible candidates only, and all original documents will be returned in person at the time of issuance of Eligibility/Equivalency certificate.

## 2. <u>Procedure for admission to Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot</u>

- Candidate having Eligibility certificate, shall apply for admission in colleges in the prescribed Admission Application form duly addressed to the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- The Application form for admission is available at the official website ie. www.bfuhs.ac.in
- It shall be sent to the University alongwith processing fee of **US\$ 200** for seeking eligibility certificate for B.Sc courses plus Rs. 2000/- or **US\$ 50** as application fee or equivalent amount in Indian rupees in the shape of demand draft in favour of the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any Bank payable in India.

## Last date for receipt of Admission Application Form is 18.09.2020

The candidate has to submit the self attested photocopies of the following documents along with application form:-

- (i) Date of Birth Certificate.
- (ii) 10+1/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
- (iii) (The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (iv) 10+2/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
- (v) (The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (vi) Explanation Sheet of grades.
- (vii) Character/Recommendation Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- (viii) Certificate/Degree/Diploma of having passed qualifying examination as a regular candidate from the recognized institution /university.
- (ix) Eligibility certificate
- (x) Three latest color self attested photographs (Passport size).
- (xi) The candidate applying under category (I) are required to submit
  - a. Photostat Copies of the passport of Father/Guardian/Candidate.
  - b. Proof of having ancestral background of Punjab.
- (xii) Demand Draft for **US\$ 200 for** B.Sc courses or equivalent in Indian Rupee.

## Eligibility criteria for admission in GGSM&C, Faridkot

- a) Candidate must be 17 years of age on or before 31st December 2020.
- **b)** Candidate should have passed the qualifying examination as regular candidate from a recognized institution in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and should have obtained 40% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- c) Candidates seeking admission under Foreign Indian Student (NRI) quota shall appear for counseling before the admission committee.

### Preference-:

The criteria laid down for admission against seats reserved for NRI Candidates will be as

under:-

Category I : NRIS/Children of NRI who originally belonged to the State of Punjab.

Category II : NRIs/Children of NRI who originally belonged to Indian State other than Punjab.

# Definition of NRI as per memo no. 5/5/2016-5ĦĦ3/5121-22 dated 08/12/2017 issued by Deptt. of Medical Education, Govt. of Punjab.

"Under this policy Non Resident Indian means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:

- (i) for or on taking up employment outside India; or
- (ii) for carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
- (iii) for any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign Country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India shall be taken into consideration.

#### Annual fee for B.Sc courses for session 2020 shall be 2000 USD.

### Note 1

- (a) The student shall give a bank guarantee/surety bond to GGS Medical College, Faridkot for the residual fee, if he/she opts to pay the fee in installments.
- (b) Selected candidates shall deposit full/1st installment of the fee at time of reporting. The payment shall be made in form of Demand Draft should be in favour of "Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot".
  - (d) The payment shall either be in USD (\$) or it equivalent in Indian Rupee & must be drawn from their own or parents NRE account along with bank certificate/statement showing that payment is drawn from candidate or parents account.

- 1. Candidates are required to submit all documents in original at the time of applying for eligibility certificate.
- 2. Statements of result issued by School / College and the un-authenticated Result Notification / Result Slip etc. will not be accepted.
- 3. After admission, candidates will be required to obtain appropriate student visa if necessary on their own.
- 4. Candidates shall also be required to obtain a Clearance Certificate from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi in due course and submit it to the Principal of the college in which they are admitted.
