

Procedure for seeking admission to B.P.T., B.M.L.T & B.Sc. Medical (APB) courses under Foreign Indian Students (NRI) Quota affiliated to the BABA FARID UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, FARIDKOT, PUNJAB(INDIA)

Session – 2020

Introduction:

Candidates seeking admission under the Foreign Indian Students (NRI) category into any of the affiliated institutions of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences in B.P.T., B.M.L.T & B.Sc. Medical (APB) courses having cleared 10+2 school qualification in appropriate subjects from any of institution/ university/ board etc. recognized and approved by the Government/University are eligible to apply. Applicants are required to first apply to the University on prescribed forms for equation of their respective qualification and issue of **Eligibility Certificate**. After obtaining the Eligibility Certificate, candidates are required to **apply afresh to the University for seeking admission in State/University/Private colleges**. All applications for equation are required to be sent to the University at its official address Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Sadiq Road, Faridkot 151203 (Pb.), INDIA on or before the expiry of the last date as may be prescribed. The physical presence of the candidates is compulsory at the time of counselling. Admission shall be strictly according to preference category wise merit as per the Punjab Govt. Notification and its amendments. After selection the candidates will be required to deposit the prescribed fee as per instructions. For date of counselling and other information please keep yourself updated by visiting our University website www.bfuhs.ac.in from time to time.

1. **Procedure for getting Eligibility Certificate**

Before applying for admission under Foreign Indian Student(NRI) quota a candidate needs to seek Equivalence/Eligibility certificate from BFUHS by applying on prescribed application performa available from the University office on payment of **Rs. 1000/-**. The performa may be downloaded from the University website www.bfuhs.ac.in and it may be sent to the University alongwith fee of **US\$ 300 for B.P.T., B.M.L.T & B.Sc. Medical (APB)** plus **US\$ 25** being the cost of the application form in the shape of demand draft/cashier's cheque in favour of the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable in India.

The applicant has to attach following documents along with the application:-

- (i) 10+1/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
(The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (ii) 10+2/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
(The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
- (iii) Explanation Sheet of grades.
- (iv) Date of Birth Certificate.
- (v) Character/Recommendation Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- (vi) Certificate/Degree/Diploma having passed qualifying examination as a regular candidate from the recognized institution /university.
- (vii) Proof of NRI status of candidate/parents

Note:- These documents should be original along with Photocopies duly attested by a competent authority.

A candidate should fill in the form preferably in his/her own handwriting & send it to the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Sadiq Road, Faridkot-151203 (Pb) India along with a Bank Draft for **US\$ 300 for B.P.T., B.M.L.T & B.Sc. Medical (APB)** or equivalent amount in Indian rupees, in

favour of the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, (Pb) India payable at Faridkot.. If the form is down loaded he/she also send **Rs. 1000/- or \$25/-** as a cost of form.

After verification of the documents, the university will issue Eligibility/Equivalency Certificate to the Eligible candidates only, and all original documents will be returned in person at the time of issue of Eligibility/Equivalency certificate.

2. Procedure for admission to State/University/Private colleges

- After getting the Eligibility Certificate from the University, the candidate has to apply for admission in Govt./University/Private colleges, on the prescribed Admission Application form to the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- The candidates who want to seek admission to private colleges can apply directly to Private colleges and send a copy of the same to the university.
- The Admission Application form for admission is available at the University counter on a payment of **Rs.2000/- or US \$ 50**.
- The candidate can also obtain this form by post on request for which the candidate has to send a Demand Draft of **Rs.2000 or US \$ 50** in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable at Faridkot.
- The candidate can also down load Admission Application form from the website of the University www.babafariduniv.com. However, if the candidate downloads the form from the Website, he will have to send an additional demand draft of **Rs.2000/- or US \$ 50** in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable at Faridkot towards the cost of this form.

After getting the Admission Application form, he has to send this duly completed form to Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, along with a bank draft of **US\$ 300 for B.P.T., B.M.L.T & B.Sc. Medical (APB)** or its equivalent amount in Indian Rupees in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable at Faridkot.

Last date for receipt of Admission Application Form at university counter is 17/08/2020

The candidate has to attach the photocopies of the following documents duly attested by the competent authority along with application form:-

- (i) 10+1/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
 - (ii) (The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
 - (iii) 10+2/ equivalent examination detailed marks certificate(s)
 - (iv) (The certificate(s) must show the marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English)
 - (v) Explanation Sheet of grades.
 - (vi) Date of Birth Certificate.
 - (vii) Character/Recommendation Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
 - (viii) Certificate/Degree/Diploma of having passed qualifying examination as a regular candidate from the recognized institution /university.
 - (ix) Eligibility certificate
 - (x) Three latest color signed and attested photographs (Passport size).
 - (xi) The candidate applying under category (I) are required to submit
 - a. Photostat Copies of the passport of Father/Guardian/Candidate.
 - b. Proof of having ancestral background of Punjab.
 - (xii) Demand Draft/ Cashier's Cheque for **US\$ 300 for B.P.T., B.M.L.T & B.Sc. Medical (APB)** or equivalent in Indian Rupee.

Eligibility criteria for State/University as well as Private Institutes

- a) Candidate must be 17 years of age on or before 31st December 2020.
- b) They should have passed in such qualifying examination as regular candidate from a recognized institution in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and should have obtained 35%(BPT), 40% B.Sc (MLT) and 50%(B.Sc Medical APB) marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology. Candidates seeking admission under Foreign Indian Student (NRI) quota must appear for counseling before the Selection committee.

Preference- :

Punjab Govt. vide its Notification no. 5/21/20083HB-III/5309 dated 21.08.2018 has notified that 15% seats in all Private Institutes and 7.5% seats in Govt./University Institutes shall be earmarked for NRI students in order to preference as under:

- Category I : NRIs/Children of NRI who originally belonged to State of Punjab
Category II : NRIs /Children of NRI who originally belonged to an Indian state other than Punjab

- (a) Under this policy Non Resident Indian Means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:
- (i) For or on taking up employment outside India ; or
 - (ii) For carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
 - (iii) For any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign Country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India Shall be taken into consideration.

This amount of fee may be paid in lump sum or installment as given below:

Fee Structure for NRI candidates:

<u>Installments</u>	B.P.T., B.M.L.T & B.Sc. Medical (APB)
First (at the time of Admission)	US \$ 8,000/-
Second (after the one year of 1 st Payment)	US \$ 3500/-
Third (after the 2 year of 1 st payment)	US \$ 3500/-

Note 1

- (a) The student will have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the residual fee, if he/she opts to pay the fee in installment as provided.
- (b) Selected Candidates will have to deposit full/1st installment of the fee on the spot.

- (c) The payment in shape of Demand Draft should be in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- (b) The payment should either be in US \$ or is drawn from their own or parents NRE account along with bank certificate/statement showing that payment is drawn from candidate or parents account.

1. All original documents are required to be submitted at the time of applying for EQUATION CERTIFICATE.
2. Statements of result issued by School / College and the un-authenticated Result Notification / Result Slip etc. will not be accepted.
3. After admission candidates will be required to obtain appropriate student visa if necessary on their own.
4. Candidates shall also be required to obtain a Clearance Certificate from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi in due course and submit it to the Principal of the college to which they are admitted.
