

Admission Notice for NRI seats in Master of Physiotherapy (MPT) Course, Session 2021

Application for issuing of Eligibility certificate is available from the University counter/can be downloaded from University website.

Eligibility:

- a. Candidate should have passed BPT with minimum 50% marks.
- b. Should have complete compulsory internship.

The admission shall be on merit determined on the basis of qualifying examination equivalent of BPT. 15% seats of total seats in private colleges are reserved for NRI's in MPT course in order to preference as under:

(a) Under this policy Non Resident Indian Means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:

- (i) For or on taking up employment outside India ; or
- (ii) For carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
- (iii) For any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign Country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India Shall be taken into consideration.

Procedure for admission to Private Physiotherapy colleges

1. Form for getting Eligibility certificate from university website. Fee for getting eligibility certificate **Rs. 2500/-** in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable at Faridkot towards the cost of this form.
2. After getting the form, he has to send this duly completed form to Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, along with a bank draft of **US \$ 500** its equivalent amount in Indian Rupees in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable at Faridkot
3. After getting the Eligibility Certificate from the University, the candidate has to apply for admission on the prescribed Admission Application form to the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

4. The candidate downloads the **Admission Application Form** from the University Website, send an additional demand draft of **Rs.3000/-** in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable at Faridkot towards the cost of this form
5. After getting the Admission Application form, he has to send this duly completed form to Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, along with a bank draft of **US \$ 500** its equivalent amount in Indian Rupees in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot drawn on any bank payable at Faridkot.
