NOTICE

The Medical Council of India, New Delhi vide notification No. MCI-18(1)/2018-Med./100818 dated 05.04.2018 imposed the following penalty clause for the candidates who will surrender / not joined the seat after 2nd round of counselling :

In view of the outbreak of COVID-19, the University is conducting the online process of counselling admission to PG courses. The university shall conduct 2nd round of online counselling shortly. It is anticipated that there may be some candidates who will submit the online options/preferences but will not join the course after declaration of result of 2nd round. Therefore, to stop this unethical practice of blocking of seat by the candidates and in consonance with the FAQ No. 63 (posted on MCC website), the competent authority decided as under :

1. If a candidate has been allotted a seat in Round-2 but not reported at the allotted Institute, he/she can exit with Forfeiture of Fees i.e. the Refundable Security Deposit will be forfeited.
2. However, once the candidate joins a seat allotted in 2nd round, he/she will not be eligible for exiting the seat and not eligible for any other round of counselling. This rule is as per directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Dar-Us-Slam case.

Keeping in view that many precious seats may not be vacated by the candidates, it has been decided that only those candidates will submit the choices / preferences for 2nd round who are firmly willing to join the allotted seat.

Keeping in view the above situation and to avoid seat blocking, the following are the instructions for immediate compliance by the candidates to be eligible for 2nd round:

1. The candidates including candidates who have already joined in 1st round of counseling, shall submit the willingness to participate in the 2nd round of online State counselling on university website.

2. The following is the refundable / adjustable registration deposit alongwith conditions for various seats in Govt. as well as private Medical/Dental colleges of State of Punjab :

Sr. No.	Preference of submitting the choice in various colleges	Refundable Registration to be deposited.
1.	For submitting the choices/preferences for Govt. colleges only	Rs. 25000/-
2.	For submitting the choices/preferences for Private Colleges, both Govt. colleges and Private Colleges including Minority institutions/ Private universities	Rs. 2,00,000/-

Note : The candidates who will not be allotted any seat during 2nd round of counselling, their refundable security deposit will be refunded.

3. The candidates who have already deposited the fee after selection in 1st round of counselling over and above the penalty amount, shall not be required to deposit the refundable registration fee for 2nd counselling.
4. The candidates shall deposit the refundable registration fee through online gateway system available on University website by logging on their ID.
5. For submitting the willingness for 2nd Round by the registered NEET PG-2020 aspirants, the applicant will log into his/her ID generated at the time of registration in 1st counselling which were sent to them on their registered mobile numbers.
6. The seats which remained vacant after 1st round of counselling and the resultant vacant seat due to non joining/surrender of seats by the selected candidates are displayed on the website of university.
7. The vacancy position of seats will be updated as and when the All India Quota seats will be reverted to State by DGHS, New Delhi.
8. The process of inviting willingness for 2nd counselling will start w.e.f. 02.06.2020 till further orders.
