Subject: - Surrender of Seat by 1st round MDS counseling joined candidate under NEET MDS -2024.

As per information bulletin posted on the website of Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) New Delhi, Govt. of India, the candidates who did not get upgrade in Round II and wanted to resign their seat of Round-1 can do so within two days of Round-II Result announcement with free exit. Therefore, the joined candidates of Round-I who did not upgraded in Round-II, can surrender the seat upto **10-08-2024** with free exit, after which they will be considered as part of Round-II and same rules will apply on them as applicable for Round-II counseling. However, any resignation after **10-08-2024** will be treated as exit with forfeiture of fee. The interested candidate will have to submit application of surrendering the seat to the Principal of concerned college to enable him to surrender the seat on the portal so that vacancy for Round-3 will get updated automatically, otherwise the candidate will be considered as joined.

FAQ Question.07 as under:

Question.7	What are the circumstances wherein the refundable security deposit will be forfeited?
Answer	<p>Under the following circumstances the refundable security deposit will be forfeited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. Where a Candidate has been allotted a seat in Round -2 or subsequent rounds and does not report at the allotted college to complete the admission process.ii. The Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled after allotment due to any reason. E.g., in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission.
