1. INTRODUCTION

BRIEF HISTORY:

The University was established at Faridkot under an Act of Punjab State Legislature (Punjab Act No. 18 of 1998) in the name of great Sufi Saint Sheikh Farid Ganj-E-Shakar, (1173 1265 A.D.) in 1998 for purposes of affiliating, teaching and ensuring proper and systematic instruction, training and research in Modern Systems of Medicine and Indian Systems of Medicine. It is not only affiliating and examining body but also a teaching and research centre in health sciences. It is expected to play a vital role in improving the standards of medical and health education in the state and in conducting relevant research in all aspects of health sciences, basic as well as applied, which ultimately will ameliorate the health standards of the people of Punjab. It is believed that the university will be a trend setter in developing appropriate modes and models of health care to ensure quality health care to the people.

The University has been recognized by MCI vide letter no. V/11015/3/2000-ME (UG) dated 9th June, 2000. The UGC has also included the University in the list of recognized universities maintained by the University Grants Commission, under section 2(1) of the UGC Act. 1956 vide letter no. F.9-3/97 (CPP-I) dated 4 July. 2002. The Regional Director, World Health Organization, Regional Office for South-East Asia, World Health House, New Delhi has also forwarded the name of the University for inclusion in the World Directory of Medical Schools vide letter No. M12/6212 dated 6 May 2002. The University is also included in the list of Commonwealth Universities and their yearbook 2001 at page No. 692 (Vol. I).

Established with a mission to create an intellectual, academic and physical environment conducive to free flow of ideas and exchange of information between various faculties of the university, between this university and other universities of health sciences in the country and abroad, thereby opening a window to the world for the health professionals, health planners, health managers, biomedical and social scientists and educationalists in health sciences of the country. Efforts are on to establish contact with various institutions towards achieving this goal.

UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS:

New buildings of the University and its constituent college, GGS Medical College & Hospital were completed in the year 2011. The university was shifted to its new building situated at Sadiq Road, Faridkot in July 2011. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab inaugurated two new University buildings (Senate Block and Academic Block) on 22-09-2011. Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister inaugurated the Radiotherapy Unit, and other buildings of GGS Medical College & Hospital, on 23-09-2011. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University is also shifted to its new building. The University Campus comprises of GGS Medical College along with Auditorium of 800 capacity, Senate Block, Academic Block, University College of Nursing, University College of Physiotherapy, University Institute of Para-Medical Sciences, University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Dept. of Nuclear Medicine, Telemedicine, Edusat and a well equipped state-of-the-art 500 bedded hospital, Drug De-addiction & Treatment Centre at Faridkot. The State Institute of Nursing and Para-Medical Sciences, Village – Badal (Muktsar), Institute of Nursing (University Regional Centre) at Shri Goindwal Sahib and Advanced Cancer Diagnostic Treatment & Research Centre and Drug De-Addiction & Treatment Centre at Bathinda, Mata Gujri State college of Nursing, Dhuri, Sangrur are also run by University. Coveted projects to set up Trauma Centre, Regional Cancer

Centre are in process. The University has added to its academic convoy University Library & Informatics Division, Department of Health Sciences Library & Information System, University Centre of Excellence in Research, Rose Garden and Herbal Garden. The university has started number of employment-oriented diploma courses and certificate programs in health sciences and allied services.

Admissions to various undergraduate and post graduate courses in the affiliated institutions of this University in the State of Punjab are made on merit basis through the conduct of Entrance Tests.

Selection of the candidates to any institution shall be made on merit and in transparent manner as per Punjab Government Notification/s.

 3. Candidates are advised to read both Part-I and Part-II of the prospectus carefully before filling and submitting the **ONLINE APPLICATION FORM**.
 4. Candidates can apply for BPT/BMLS /B.Sc.(APB)- 2026 through “Online” mode only.
 5. Online submission of Application Form may be made by accessing University website i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in
 6. Instructions for Online submission of Application Form are available in the Prospectus and on the University website www.bfuhs.ac.in
 7. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Prospectus and University website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.

18. The schedule of Admission/Counselling shall be notified through the University, website. In case of changes (if any), no separate intimation letters will be sent. Candidates are advised to visit the University website i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in regularly.
19. Candidates must retain this Prospectus with them till admission process is over. Read and comply with all instructions therein strictly.
20. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in Part – B of the Prospectus. The Final Eligibility of allocated candidate shall be determined by the Principal of concerned Colleges before Joining of the candidate.
21. CBSE (Council of Board of School Education in India) grant membership to boards/institutions that are set up by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature or by Executive orders of the Central / State Government and broadly follow the National Curriculum Framework/CBSE. Therefore, candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from member-boards of CBSE are acceptable for admissions. A complete list of members-boards of CBSE can be downloaded from www.cbse.in Boards not in the list of members-boards of CBSE shall not be acceptable for admissions. The Board of Management in its meeting held on 21.08.2013 vide para no. 28, resolved that the list of Boards recognized by CBSE shall be considered for admission to higher courses run by the University.

22. The list of Colleges and availability of seats shown at various places in this prospectus/website may vary and the final status shall be displayed at the time of counselling.
23. The candidate should read the eligibility conditions carefully. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in the Notification. Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned College. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the allocated candidate before joining/admission. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Government Notification will not be considered for admission.
24. Fill category carefully in the online Admission Application Form. Category once claimed will not be changed in any case after submitting the form.
25. Those candidates, who do not fill/claim any category code as per prospectus or fill a wrong category code other than mentioned in prospectus, will be treated in Open merit. The candidate may select a category code from the codes given in the Prospectus and fill the category accordingly. More than one category may be filled by a candidate if it is considered applicable in the candidate's particular case. Category codes are exclusively for the purpose of facilitating the candidates to know and understand his/her respective merit placement at the time of counseling in various reserved categories as have been filled by him/her. Reserve category selection on the part of the candidate shall not in any case be construed to give him/her any legitimacy or right or claim on the benefits for reserved seats during admission. Claims to admissions against reserved seats will be on the basis of appropriate claims made in the online Admission Application Form subject to rules and regulations contained in the Punjab Government Notifications printed in the Part-B of this prospectus and as per the decisions of the Selection Committee constituted for this purpose by the Punjab Government. No benefit of reservation whatsoever shall be given if the claim is not made in Admission Application Form. Change in category or any other particular is allowed before the last date for submission of application form and thereafter no change will be allowed under any circumstances.
26. Candidates will be responsible for any mistakes made by him/her in his/her application form. University shall not be responsible for the same.

28. Personal appearance of candidates is essential at the time of reporting at provisionally allocated college. Candidate will produce all documents/ testimonials in original for verification before the college Admission Committee failing which he/she will not be considered for admission.
29. **Reservations of seats** in the affiliated institutions in Punjab shall be as per the policy of the Government of Punjab.
30. The **Online Admission Application Form** shall be rejected if:
 - a) The entries are incomplete,
 - b) The required enclosures are not duly self attested.
 - c) Requisite fee not received
31. Notwithstanding the submission of application form, only eligible candidates, as per Government notification/s, shall be considered for admission.

32. The eligibility for admission of the candidates shall be determined as per Punjab Govt. Notification by the concerned College Admission Committee at the time of reporting after allotment of seat.
33. The candidate may opt for admission to his/her desirable course and institution at the time of online counselling. The candidate may opt to change choice of station and course at the time of online counselling.

1. Before applying, candidate should carefully read PROSPECTUS for eligibility conditions and other important instructions.
2. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. **Submitting more than one application by a candidate is liable to be rejected.**
3. Candidate ensures that he/she has completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2026.

5. After filling online application form by candidate, University will issue a Unique Registration Id. Registration id (i.e. Login Id) and password will be provided to the candidate at his/her registered E-mail id & Mobile Number through SMS.
6. It is mandatory to fill the Bank Account details accurately and upload the cancelled cheque/copy of passbook of the candidate positively for refund purpose. In case candidate filled wrong Bank details then the University is not responsible and all the responsibility will be of the candidate for delay/non refund of fee.
7. Candidate should have to apply online by due date. After this online application form will not be available at the University website and no request will be entertained in this regard.

8. **Fee should be deposited by specified date/time.** Fee once deposited will not be refunded/adjusted in any case.
9. Date should be filled in the format of dd/mm/yyyy i.e. date/month/year.
10. Registration No and Password is mandatory for further process, so keep it secret and don't disclose to any unknown person.
11. You have to login to upload Photograph, Edit Application, Application Status and to change your password options.
12. How to upload Photograph, Signature, Left Thumb Impression: You have to login by entering your Registration No and Password. ONLINE COUNSELING:

The University will conduct online counseling. Candidate will submit choice/preference of college/Quota/Category by login their registered id within a stipulated date & time and seat/college will be allotted as per choices/preferences and merit.

Note-1: Choices/preferences will only be edited / updated within stipulated date & time.

Note-2: The Principals of allotted colleges shall ensure to constitute committee at college level comprising of representatives of District Department of social justice and empowerment, District Sainik Welfare Department, District Sports Department and senior faculty of the college to check the eligibility and verify the credentials of the candidates and any discrepancy be brought to the notice of the University immediately. Since, the process of counseling is online and the University has no mechanism to check the eligibility of the candidate, it is the sole responsibility of the Principal(S) to verify & check the documents of the candidates at college level itself. The Provisional selected candidates shall deposit the tuition fee through online payment gateway of University.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE COUNSELLING

1. Online counselling will be held through University Website and online counselling form will be made available on University Website as per dates specified in Important Dates.
2. The Principals must ensure the following:
 - a) Their Internet connection at college is intact and working
 - b) Joining of the candidate will be online mode only i.e. through College Login ID.
 - c) Excuse of Poor connectivity will not be entertained.
 - d) Committee comprising of Senior Faculty be constituted for scrutiny of documents/checking of eligibility of candidates.
 - e) Deposition of tuition fee be made through online payment gateway system only.
3. The candidates should read the eligibility conditions carefully and just exercising online option of college / appearing in counselling does not entitle him/her for admission. Eligibility conditions for admissions are as per Punjab Govt. Notification(s). The eligibility shall be determined by the Selection Committee constituted by the Principal at college level. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Govt. notification will not be considered for admission.
4. The choice(s) of courses/institutions shall be exercised by the candidate through online portal only at the time of Counseling.
5. The allotment of seat and college shall be made as per the choices/preferences on the basis of the merit determined as per marks obtained by the candidate in 10+2 examination and other terms and conditions contained in the Punjab Government Notification.
6. The candidates shall have to produce all the certificates/degrees/diplomas/documents in original at the time of joining/admission in respective colleges or at the time of physical counseling.
7. **Checking/Verification of Original Certificate/Documents:** Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Colleges. After provisional allocation of seat, candidate shall have to report to the allocated college for fee deposition, verification of documents and checking of eligibility. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the provisionally allocated candidate before their joining/admission.
8. **Deposition of Fee:** After provisional allocation during online counseling, the candidate will deposit tuition fee (as per Punjab Govt. notification) through online payment gateway only. Candidate will report for medical checkup and joining in the respective allotted college alongwith receipt of fee paid and original documents for verification within stipulated time/period, failing which allocated seat will stand cancelled automatically without any intimation to the candidate.
9. **The tuition fee for B.Sc. Paramedical courses at Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital, Sangrur is Rs. 30000/- per year.**

ELIGIBILITY / INSTRUCTIONS FOR NRI CANDIDATES

The qualified candidates who seeks to apply under NRI quota seats, have to obtain provisional Eligibility/equivalency certificate from the BFUHS, Faridkot and will have to apply on prescribed format available on university website alongwith prescribed fee for NRI seats.

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign Country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India shall be taken into consideration.

The admission under NRI category shall be strictly according to preference category wise merit as per Punjab Govt. notification/instructions. After selection, the

candidate will be required to deposit the prescribed fee as per instructions.

The following is the procedure of admission under NRI Category:

Application form for issuing of Eligibility/ Equivalency certificate is available in the Admission Branch BFUHS, Faridkot and can be downloaded from University website (www.bfuhs.ac.in).

As per Punjab Govt. notification 15% seats in all Private Institutes and 7.5 of seats in Government/University Institutes shall be earmarked for the Non-Resident Indians in the following Order:

Category I : NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to the state of Punjab.

For any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign Country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India Shall be taken into consideration.

PROCEDURE OF ONLINE COUNSELING AND JOINING AT THE COLLEGES

Counselling for admission to BPT/BMLS/B.Sc. Medical(APB), session 2026 will be conducted online followed by Physical reporting of the candidates at provisional allotted college. During online counseling, candidates will fill online counselling form wherein they will give their preferences of course, college, category, quota. The Provisional Seat will be allocated as per the merit of qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 and in order of preferences given by the candidate. Therefore, candidates are advised to take care during filling up the order of preferences of course, college, category, quota. Candidates of reserved categories (who scored marks equivalent or more than the minimum cut-off of open merit) will also be considered in open merit, if open merit seat is available then seat of open merit will be allocated first, otherwise seat of reserved category will be allocated.

After provisional allocation of seat, candidates can download provisional allocation letter from the University website after login to their account and report to the respective college along with all original documents for the checking of documents and their eligibility. Merely, issuing of Provisional Selection Slip does not confer any right to claim the allocation of seat in respective college as their provisional selection is subject to verification of documents and checking of eligibility as per guidelines of Punjab Govt. Notification enshrined in the Prospectus.

If any candidate does not submit his/her joining to the Principal of respective college, his/her allocated seat will be cancelled automatically without any intimation and his/her seat shall be declared as vacant for the subsequent round of counseling.

If candidate is satisfied with seat allocated to him/her during online counselling, he/she is not required to participate in the subsequent round of counselings. In case, candidate wishes/intends to upgrade/change his/her seat he/she will have to participate in the subsequent round of counselling and give his/her preferences afresh for the course/college/category/quota.

In case any candidate wants to quit the course/seat, he/she will have to submit application to the Principal of respective college regarding his/her surrender of seat well in advance before start of next round of counselling.

In case candidate seat is upgraded/changed in the subsequent round of counselling and he/she has already deposited the tuition fee, he/she is not required to deposit fee again, provided he/she has to deposit the difference in fee, if any.

It is pertinent to mention here that the candidates can fill the choices of colleges/quota which are not reflecting in the vacancy position of seats. In this regard, it is made clear that during 2nd online counseling one can upgrade/shift seat as per his/her choice by vacating the already occupied seat of 1st counseling. This is also made clear that some seats of reserve category, NRI Quota seats etc may remain vacant after exhausting all candidates of respective quota as per notification. Moreover, any seat may become vacant in 2nd round due to shifting/conversion of seats. Hence, it is not mandatory to fill only those choices/preference which are reflected in the vacancy position of seats. So candidates are advised to fill the preference/choices of colleges as per their choice. The seats in 2nd round will be allocated as per availability of seats as per merit cum choice/preference submitted by the candidate.

Eligibility for admission to BPT and BMLS courses will be as per revised guidelines issued by Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, National Commission, vide File No.Z-1011/2026/NCAHP(AHS)/UGC/FTS No. 8384323 Dated 09.01.2026 for Degree, admission Criteria and other details for Allied and Healthcare Professional Programmes.

As per NCAHP guidelines issued vide letter dated 09.01.2026, there is a provision for Lateral Entry in Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Sciences (BMLS) Course as under :

1. GENERAL:

- 1.1 The Government of Punjab is pleased to authorize Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot to make admission in Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT) and Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) and B.Sc. Medical (Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry) in various institutions, in the State of Punjab, for the year 2018 and onwards. All the institutions whether Government or private, aided or unaided, minority/non-minority shall be covered by this notification.
- 1.2 The admission to such course shall be on the basis of inter-se-merit based on marks in the qualifying examination.
- 1.3 The Government of Punjab is further pleased to notify that all the seats in the Government/ University and the seats of Government/Management quota in private colleges shall be filled up on the basis of inter-se-merit of the qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 (Medical). The admission to minority institutions in the state of Punjab shall be done as per the notification/instructions/guidelines/rules/executive orders passed by the state Govt. as per provisions of The Punjab Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of admission, Fixation of fee and making of Reservation) Act, 2006 as amended from time to time.
- 1.4 The Governor of Punjab is further pleased to notify that no institution shall select candidates out of any other source, or in any other manner than inter-se-merit of the candidates on the basis merit list. However, for the minority quota seats, the inter-se-merit of the candidates of the concerned minority only shall be considered. There shall be no overlapping or bye-passing of inter-se-merit of candidates seeking admission to seats in management/minority quota except the Foreign Indian Residents (NRI) quota seats. Remaining left over seats shall be filled by Government/ Private Institutions itself after due notice to DRME as well as Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
2. The candidates shall apply for admission to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot for admission to the state as well as Govt./Management quota seats for the management/Minority including Foreign Indian student (NRI) quota seats.
 - 2.1 The candidate while applying shall submit four identical clear passport size color photographs, which must be signed by the candidate and attested on the front side for centralized counseling as a proof of identification.
 - 2.2 Male candidates shall affix their, Left Thumb Impression (LTI) and female candidates shall affix their Right Thumb Impression (RTI) at the prescribed place on the Admission Form. One thumb impression of the admitted candidate shall be taken by the Principal of the institution concerned.
 - 2.3 The conditions and modalities for centralised counseling and onwards, would be decided by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, to be published in the Prospectus in a detailed schedule for admission indicating date of availability of prospectus, last date for submission of applications, OMR form, date of submission of form for admission, details regarding total seats, list of colleges for each course. The complete schedule will also be published on website of the University, last date for

admission as per the schedule laid down by Government/ Central Council/ Courts shall be adhered to by the University.

- 2.4 The Selection Lists of provisionally selected candidates in counseling shall be published by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot on its website. The details of website will be published in the Prospectus.

3. **INSTITUTIONS AND SEATS:**

The details of the institutions and the total seats available in each institution for all categories affiliated with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot will be given in the prospectus. Categories wise distribution shall be as per provision in the Punjab Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of admission, Fixation of fee and making of Reservation) Act 2006 and notifications issued from time to time by the State Government.

NOTE-1: THE DETAILS OF PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS AND THEIR SEAT DISTRIBUTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PUNJAB GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS ISSUED AS PER PROVISIONS OF THE PUNJAB PRIVATE HEALTH SCIENCES EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (REGULATION OF ADMISSION FIXATION OF FEE AND MAKING OF RESERVATION) ACT, 2006.

NOTE-2: THE INSTITUTES, WHICH GET PERMISSION FROM ALL THE AUTHORITIES, CONCERNED INCLUDING CENTRAL COUNCILS WHERE EVER APPLICABLE AND ARE AFFILIATED TO BABA FARID UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, FARIDKOT BY 30TH SEPTEMBER OF THE CORRESPONDING YEAR, FOR STARTING THE COURSE OR ALTERATION OF SEATS MAY BE CONSIDERED FOR ADMISSION.

4. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

- (A) The candidate should be a bonafide resident of Punjab. The resident status of Punjab state shall be taken in terms of Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative reforms (PP-II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3 PP II/9619, dated 6th June, 1996, ID No. 1/2/96-3PP-2/8976, dated 7th July, 1998 and ID No. 1/3/95-3PP/II/81, dated 1st January 1999 and any further instructions issued by the Department of Personnel, if any, and the same shall be adhered to. Candidate must have passed 10+1 and 10+2 examination from Punjab. Candidate who passed his/her 10-1 and 10+2 examinations or other equivalent examination from a recognized School/Institution situated in Chandigarh (Union Territory), who is bonafide resident of Punjab shall also be eligible. The candidate must have studied Physics, Chemistry and Biology in 10+1 examination 10+2 examination.

The following categories shall be exempted from this condition:

- (i) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government employees, members of All India Services borne on Punjab cadre, Serving Judges and the employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies established by an act of the State of Punjab who have been holding post outside Punjab on or before 1st January of the year of admission that is on or before 1st January 2018 onwards and their children/wards/dependants were compelled to do 10+1 and/or 10+2 outside Punjab.
- (ii) Children wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central Government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out of the three years preceding the year of 2018 and corresponding years but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependants were compelled to do 10+1 and/or 10+2 or equivalent qualifying examination outside Punjab. However, those who remained posted in

Punjab continuously for these three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.

- (iii) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those Punjab Government pensioners who have retired on or before 1st January of the year of admission that is on or before 1st January 2018 and corresponding years and have settled outside Punjab on or before 1st January of the year of admission that is on or before 1st January 2018 and corresponding years and their children/wards/dependants were compelled to do 10+1 and/or 10+2 outside Punjab.
- (iv) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of those military/para military forces personnel who were born in the territory of Punjab as per their service record at the time of entry into service.
- (v) Children /wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of those Ex-employees of military/para military forces who were born in the territory of Punjab as per their service record at the time of entry into the service and have retired on or after 1st January of the year preceding two years of the year of admission of 2018 and onwards.
- (vi) Candidates who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions respectively.
- (vii) Candidates seeking admission under Foreign Indian Students (NRI) category.
- (viii) Candidates under J & K Migrant's category.
- (ix) Wards of defence personnel posted in Punjab.
- (x) Candidates under Tsunami Victims category.

Note-1: For those candidates who are repeaters in categories (i) to (v) the year of admission the purpose of all these clauses shall be taken as the year of passing 1012 examination by the candidates in place of 2018 and onwards.

Note-2: The dependency certificate in case of those whose parents are not alive shall have also to be taken from the Deputy Commissioner of the District where the candidate resides.

- (B) **Result not declared** – A candidate who has appeared for qualifying examination but whose result has not been declared can apply but his/her result must be declared before the counseling. The candidate will be required to produce the evidence of the result having been declared and he/she having passed the examination fulfilling the eligibility conditions by the time of counseling.
- (C) **Age:** Candidate must have completed the age of 17 years, on or before 31st December of the corresponding year.
- (D) If students from Punjab are not available than students from outside Punjab can also be considered except for the exemptions wherever applicable. The candidate would be required to submit a certificate to this effect from the Principal/Head of the Institute last attended in the Prescribed Proforma.
- (E) In case candidate has also taken up Mathematics along with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English then the marks obtained in Mathematics are not to be considered for admission.
- (F) **Marks required in qualifying examination.**

(i) For B.P.T Course:

Candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually in 10+2 examination and must have obtained a minimum of 35%

marks (pass marks in case of SC/BC) taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in 10+2 examination.

(ii) For B.Sc (M.L.T.) Course:

A candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in 10+2 (Medical) examination and must have obtained minimum of 40% aggregate marks (35% for SC/BC) taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

(iii) For B.Sc. Medical (APB)

A candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually in 10-2 examination and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks (40% for SC/BC) taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in 10-2 examination.

(iv) Inter-se merit

The selection shall be strictly as per merit of qualifying examination. The candidate may opt to change choice of station and course at the time of counseling. Counseling shall be compulsory. The schedule of the counseling and details distribution of seats shall be published by the University on its website.

- i) Firstly the Candidate having higher percentage of aggregate marks at 10+2 levels in Physics/Chemistry/Biology & English (PCBE) calculated up to 3 decimal points.
- ii) Then the Candidate having higher marks in the subject of Biology in qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 or equivalent examination.
- iii) Candidate older in age.

C. Explanation: The following points shall be observed while granting above Reservation both in government and in private colleges:

- (i) The reservation of physically challenged persons shall be as per the provision of Right of Persons with Disability Act – 2016. The Medical Board to determine requisite disability at the time of admission will be constituted by the Chairman Selection Committee/ University.
- (ii) For the claim of reservation in category (viii) above a certificate to this effect issued by Inspector General Police (IIQ), Punjab shall have to be produced while submitting other documents. In case of Paramilitary Forces, this certificate shall be countersigned by IG Police (IIQ) Punjab.
- (iii) The above reservation will be made in each Course/ college separately subject to the availability of seats as per instructions issued by the Government of Punjab from time to time. The reservation in each institution shall not exceed 25 % in case of SC and 35% in case of SC and BC combined together.
- (iv) Candidate belonging to Reserve Category will be eligible for admission as per their combined merit in 10+2 and corresponding years in General category also, if they opt for the same. There shall be no reservation in the Minority Quota in the private Institute.
- (v) General category counseling shall be held on first day. The reserved category candidate selected shall have the right to be selected in General category as per his/her merit. The reserved category candidate selected in General category will not be counted towards reserve category.
- (vi) Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserve category shall be merged with the general category.

6. Foreign Indian Students NRI SEATS:

- 6.1 **Seats-** 15% seats in all private Institutes and 7.5% of seats in Government/ University Institutes shall be earmarked for the Foreign Indian Students (NRI). The Foreign Indian Students (NRI) quota in private institutes will be part of the management quota.
- 6.2 The candidates for Foreign Indian Students (N.R.I.) seats in these institutions will be admitted on merit determined on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination equivalent to 10+2 examination of P.S.E.B./ C.B.S.E./ I.C.S.E in physics, chemistry and biology and English (PCBE) taken together. The equivalence, merit and

eligibility of the candidates will be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, who will issue an eligibility certificate to such candidates. They are not required to take the entrance test. However, they should have passed in such qualifying examinations in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually as regular candidate from the recognized institute/university and should have obtained at least 50% marks. For admission to State/University institutes of Nursing, against Foreign Indian Students (NRI) seats the candidate shall apply to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot and for private colleges candidates shall apply to concerned colleges on the prescribed form for Foreign Indian Students (NRI) seats as per provision the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of admission, Fixation of fee and making of Reservation) Act 2006 as amended from time to time.

6.3 Non-Resident Indian (NRI) SEATS:

15% seats in all Private Institutes shall be earmarked for the Non-Resident Indians in the following order:

Category I: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to the State of Punjab.

Category II: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to an Indian State other than Punjab.

I) Under this policy Non Resident Indian means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:

- (i) for or on taking up employment outside India ; or
- (ii) for carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
- (iii) for any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India shall be taken into consideration.

II) The eligibility of the candidates shall be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot who shall issue an eligibility certificate to each such candidate.

III) The NRI students shall have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments as provided.

IV) The Centralized Counselling of NRI quota seats shall be held before the Counselling for other categories. In case of any seat remaining vacant under NRI quota, it shall go to General category and in the Private Colleges shall go to General Category of the Management quota. The NRI left over seats shall be filled by the same Admission Committee.

Note - (a) **If sufficient number of candidates under first category are eligible and available then they will admitted first even if students under subsequent category are higher in merit.**

(b) **The Foreign Indian Students (NRI) will have to submit a bank guarantee/surety bond for the Balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments.**

- 7.2 **Declaration by students-** Candidates and their parents will have to give a declaration if they (candidates) have already got admission in a course in any other State that they will leave that seat if they opt for admission through merit and will send a copy of the declaration to the concerned institute where they have already deposited fee/occupied a seat. They shall also give a declaration that they have not got admission in any other state.
- 7.3 **Students already admitted in previous years-** A candidate who has already taken admission in the previous year (s) in any course, governed by this notification, shall not be eligible to seek admission in 2018 and corresponding years in the same course, however, he/she will be allowed to take admission in any other course, only if, he/she produces an NOC from the college where he/she is studying. If any candidate who is admitted during the academic session 2018 and corresponding years in any institute/course at any place may opt for admission 2018 and corresponding years by submitting a sworn declaration on or before the day of 2nd counseling that he/she surrenders the earlier seat. The candidate who had in the previous years secured admission to any particular course are hereby granted eligibility for taking admission -2018 and corresponding years examination for fresh admission except in the same course to which they had already been admitted.

- (g) The selection of candidates seeking admission to **B.P.T., M.L.T and B.Sc. Medical (APB) courses** in the Colleges in the State of Punjab and affiliated with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot will be based on merit.
- (h) In order to ensure completion of the prescribed course(s) and period of study as well as commencement of examination(s) in time, no admission(s)/ adjustment(s) shall be made after **30th September** of each year regardless of any vacancy (ies) that might exist or might arise thereafter for any reason whatsoever.
- (i) **Transfer of seats to management/Government quota** - Government quota seats remaining vacant will be transferred to management quota and vice versa filled up by the respective Selection Committee at institute level as per provisions of this notification as per para-8.
- (j) **No admissions shall be made after September 30th of each year including the left over seats.**
- (k) It will be obligatory on the part of the University to provide registration number to all the candidates once duly admitted.
- (l) For any dispute arising out of this notification or of the admissions under this notification, the jurisdiction shall be Punjab and Chandigarh only.
- (m) This notification supersedes all the notifications for admission to **B.P.T., M.L.T and B.Sc. Medical (APB) courses** in the State, issued earlier.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The eligibility of the candidate for the state quota is as under:

- a) The candidate should be Citizen of India.
- b) The candidate must have passed 10+1 & 10+2 from the state of Punjab or
- c) The candidate should have born in the state of Punjab or
- d) The candidate must be a "Permanent Resident" in the state of Punjab

Note :- "Permanent resident" in the State of Punjab means: -

i) Candidates who have studied for a period of 5 years in Punjab or have studied in Punjab for 2 years just preceding the qualifying examination for the admission. or

ii) **Children wards of**

- a) The employees of Punjab Govt. posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having atleast 3 years of service.or
- b) The employee of Govt. of India posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. or
- c) The employees of State Govt. institutions/undertakings who are posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. or
- d) The employees having atleast 3 years of service in autonomous bodies/companies in which Punjab Govt. has 20% or more shares. or
- e) The Residents who are residing outside Punjab on Account of their service either with the GOI or with the employees of the Govt. of Punjab in the matter of issue of 'Residence Certificate' provided the permanent address of such employees fall in the reorganized Punjab i.e. on or after 01.11.66, as per their service books. or
- f) *The employees borne on the establishment of Punjab and the Haryana High Court discharging duties in connection with the affairs of the State of Punjab having atleast three years of service who have

not availed this facility from their parent State and State of Haryana and U.T; Chandigarh. or

- iii) Children/wards of the pensioners of Punjab Government irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a state other than Punjab or he has settled after retirement in or outside Punjab.or
- iv) Children/wards of persons who have settled in Punjab or had resided in Punjab for a period of atleast 5 years at any time prior to the date of submission of the application either in pursuit of a profession or holding of a job.

In addition the following categories of candidates are also eligible for admission in

- a) Wards of defense personnel posted in Punjab.
- b) Candidates seeking admissions under NRI category.
- c) Candidates belonging to minority community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions.
- d) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central Government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/ Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out of the three years preceding year of passing 10+2 examination but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependents have passed class XI and/or XII or equivalent qualifying examinations from outside Punjab. However those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for these three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.

Provided however, that in case adequate number of candidates is not available for the course, then candidates who are not eligible for state quota may be considered.

9. **FEE:** The University constituent colleges shall charge the tuition fee as per Punjab Govt. Letter No. 7/107/2012-5SS3/209 dated 11.02.2015.





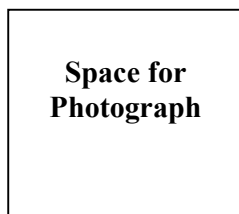
